#### **Finance Council News**

St. Barnabas will realize expenditures of about \$65,000 in this quarter for the archdiocesan parish assessment, the Mary Queen of Saints school subsidy and parish insurance. We received an insurance settlement from Catholic Mutual for the St. Rita site of about \$60,000 due to the initial pipe burst earlier in the year. eCIO has been chosen as the investment firm for our parish accounts and we are actively working with eCIO to define our investment strategy. Final results for the parish festival reflect a \$2,000 loss. We believe this was due primarily to the poor weather over the festival weekend. Mother's Heart Learning Center has leased Holy Assumption for before & after school day care.

#### St. Barnabas Support of Flood Victims

During the month of September, we will be conducting a special collection at all masses for our fellow parishioners who were impacted by the flood on August 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. Additionally, all net proceeds from the September Fish Fry will be donated to our *Parishioner Flood Victim Fund*. St. Barnabas will match all funds raised during this special collection - up to \$10,000.

A committee has been formed to determine how best to disperse the funds to our parishioners in need including creating a form to request funds from our Parish Flood Fund. (Please see the insert in this week's bulletin for more information.) Many parishioners were impacted by the flood. Some have had to seek alternative housing.

Please prayerfully consider donating to those in need in our community. We expect pay out in October.

Questions about this special collection may be referred to Phil Ryback on the Finance Council.

# St. Barnabas Flood Victim Relief

St. Barnabas, as we move from maintenance to mission, would like to offer support to our parishioners who were significantly impacted by the recent flood on August 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025. We realize many parishioners were affected by the flood and know that some suffered significant damage (e.g. structural damage, loss of mechanicals, washers and dryers, cars, household goods, etc.). Our intent is to help those parishioners who are most in need. However, every parishioner who files a claim will receive support.

#### Claims process:

- 1. All registered parishioners, as of the flood date, who suffered a loss due to the flood are eligible for parishioner payout.
- 2. Parishioners will be asked to complete a form either on-line or on paper. On the form, parishioners will need to complete personal information (name, address, etc.) and provide a dollar amount range estimate of loss and written description of the loss.
- 3. The parish's intent is to offer tiered assistance based on the extent of the loss and individual needs.
- 4. Forms must be completed either on-line or returned to the Parish Office no later than October 1, 2025.
- 5. A special committee has been formed to review the submissions and make recommendations for the distribution of collected funds.
- 6. The special committee, as stewards of the collected funds, will determine the amount to be paid out to each parishioner based on need and amount collected.
- 7. All funds collected will be distributed exclusively to those parishioners who have identified a loss.
- 8. Parishioner payouts will be made by check in mid-October 2025.
- 9. All claim submissions and payout amounts will remain confidential. The special committee, Father Carcar, the Trustees and the Parish Bookkeeper will be the only individuals who will see any information related to the claim.
