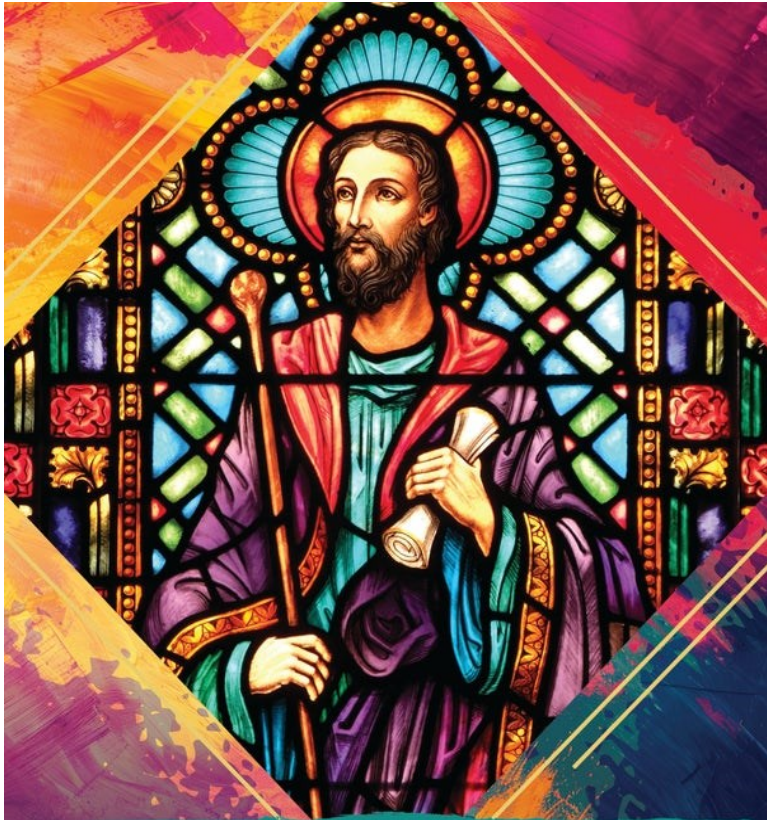

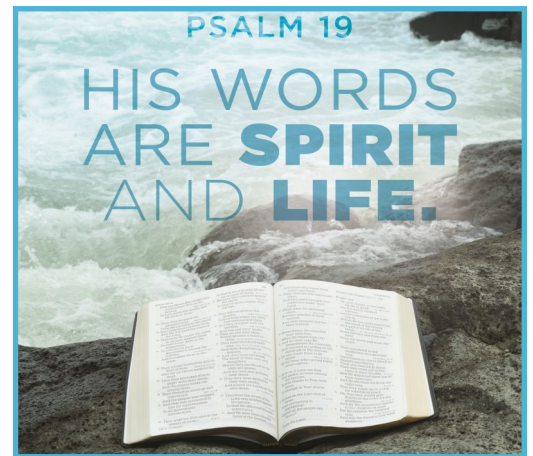

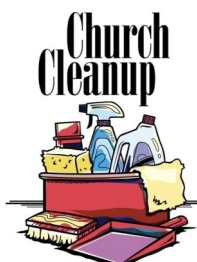
### Sleeping Bag Ministry

### de Chantal Gatherings for Women



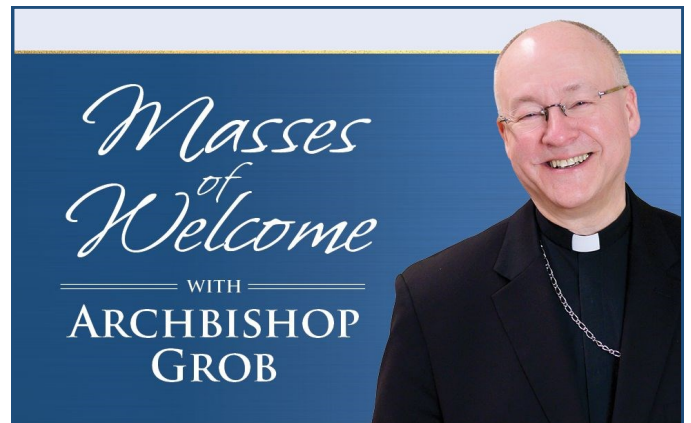
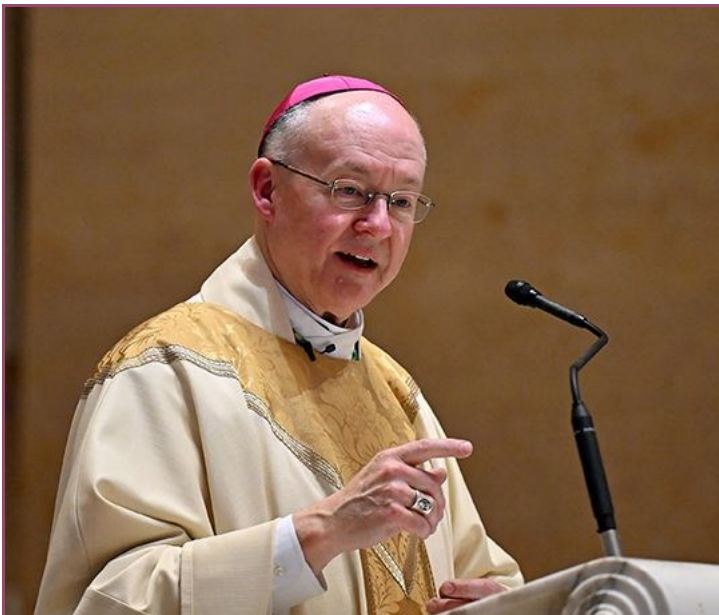
