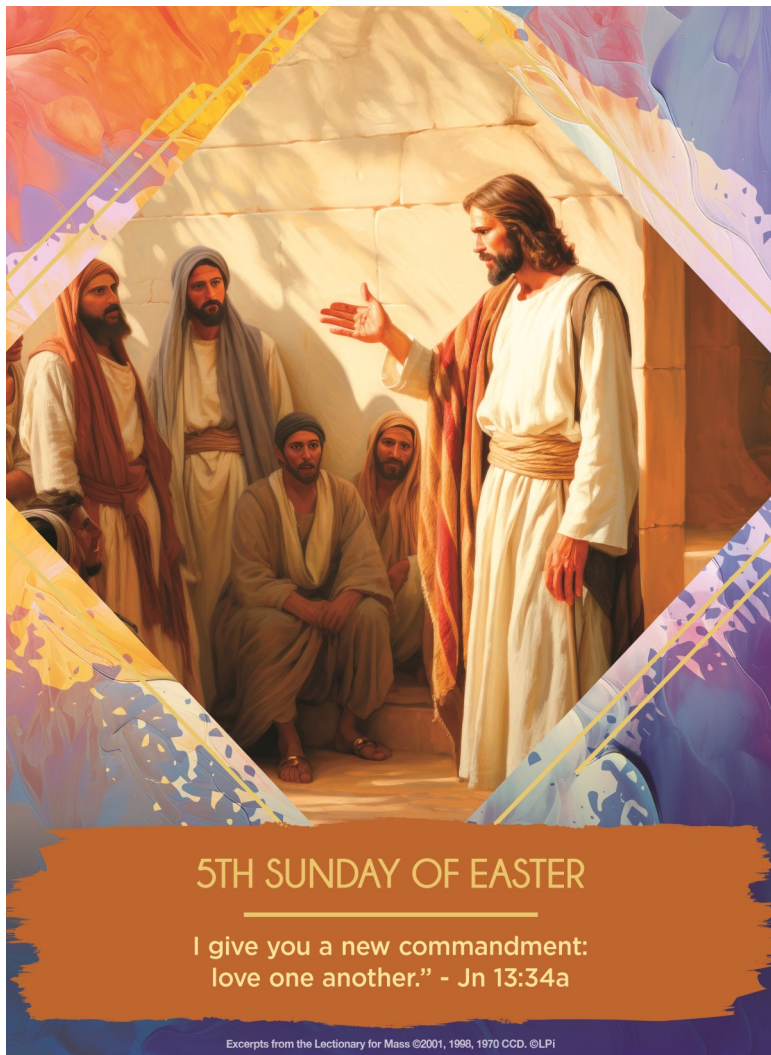

A new Pastoral Council term begins on July 1st. Member discernment will be in June. Stay tuned for more details!

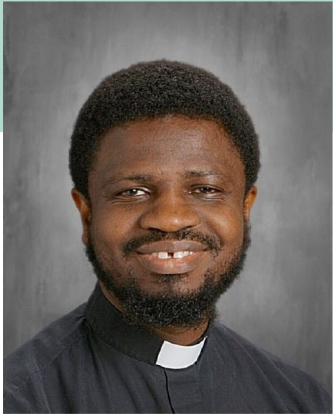
