

About the Saint Barnabas Pastoral Council

The Saint Barnabas Pastoral Council is a group of forward-thinking, strategic, and visionary leaders who advise our Pastor on how to grow and develop our parish.

Now that we have been Saint Barnabas Catholic Congregation for one year, it is time to restructure our Pastoral Council a bit. Since the beginning of collaboration in 2021, the various Pastoral Councils and Collaboration Committees have had representation from each legacy parish, and for good reason. Now that we are one parish, however, this is no longer necessary; we will have representation from Saint Barnabas Catholic Congregation.

Pastoral Council will meet monthly; historically, meetings have been on the third Wednesday of each month (with some adjustments made around the liturgical calendar), though this can be discussed at our first meeting. Priorities for this term will include parish ministry alignment, moving from maintenance to mission, and whatever else Pastoral Council decides to pursue.

Acerca del Consejo Pastoral de San Bernabé

El Consejo Pastoral de San Bernabé es un grupo de líderes con visión de futuro, estratégicos y visionarios que asesoran a nuestro párroco sobre cómo crecer y desarrollar nuestra parroquia.

Tras un año como Congregación Católica de San Bernabé, es hora de reestructurar un poco nuestro Consejo Pastoral. Desde el inicio de la colaboración en 2021, los diversos Consejos Pastorales y Comités de Colaboración han contado con representación de cada parroquia histórica, y con razón. Sin embargo, ahora que somos una sola parroquia, esto ya no es necesario; contaremos con representación de la Congregación Católica de San Bernabé.

El Consejo Pastoral se reunirá mensualmente; históricamente, las reuniones se han celebrado el tercer miércoles de cada mes (con algunos ajustes según el calendario litúrgico), aunque esto se puede tratar en nuestra primera reunión. Las prioridades para este periodo incluirán la alineación del ministerio parroquial, la transición del mantenimiento a la misión y cualquier otra tarea que el Consejo Pastoral decida llevar a cabo.
