The Finance Ministry Team of Front Street United Methodist Church met on Tuesday, June 9, 2026 with the following members present:

Chairman Charles Canaday welcomed everyone and asked Ray to open the meeting with prayer. The minutes from the April 14, 2026 meeting were approved.

William reviewed the May 2026 financial statement. Year-to-date, the organization has a deficit of \$711.93, which is effectively a break-even position. Contributions are higher and expenditures are lower compared to the same period last year. Charles commended the staff for their continued efforts in managing expenses. William stated that he plans to modify the financial statement summary page to address questions regarding the accumulated deficit. He also indicated that he would be willing to prepare a quarterly financial report to accompany the quarterly contribution statements.

The board briefly discussed the designated funds, including the number of funds and their intended uses. William agreed to provide a report on all designated funds at the next meeting.

Ray and Tammy shared an update on the Sanctuary Project, a three-month pilot program involving nine local churches that provide financial support to the project. The program is administered by the Women's Resource Center and is designed to assist individuals with financial needs in a broader and more consistent manner than individual churches can provide independently. During May, the program received 30 referrals and was able to assist 12 families before available funds were exhausted.

Tammy announced that the next meeting is scheduled for August 11, 2026. Charles raised the possibility of holding the meeting virtually. With no objections from the board, it was decided that the August meeting will be conducted via Zoom.

There was no other business brought up.

Ray asked Rett Davis to close in prayer.

The meeting was adjourned.
