FAMILY FUN NIGHT

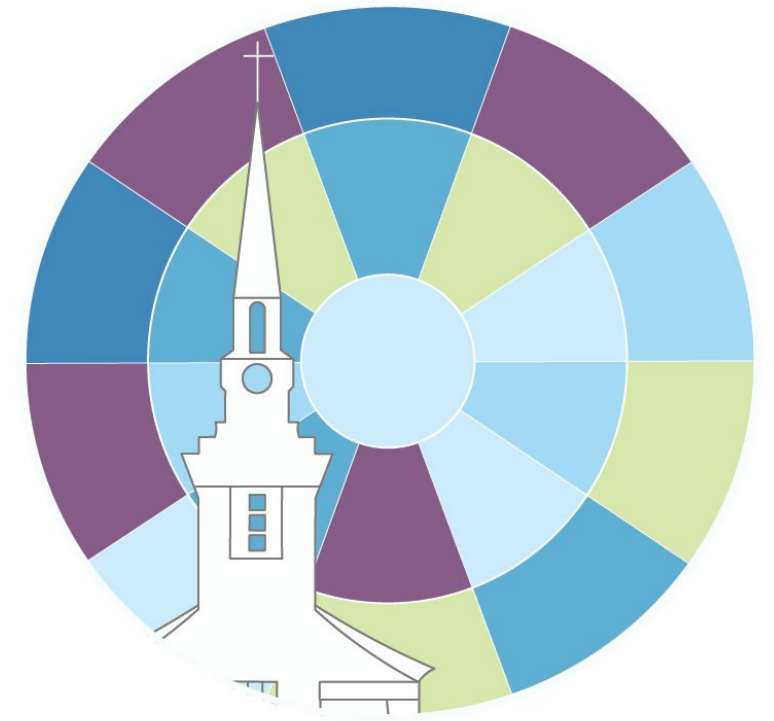
