

FAQs

How are ages divided up?

Players are grouped by birth year. We group birth years together so that we can properly populate each age group in order to create 10 to 12 full teams with 10 to 12 players.

U15 (under 15) – Birth Years 2011, 2012, and 2013

U12 (under 12) – Birth Years 2014 and 2015

U10 (under 10) – Birth Years 2016 and 2017

U8 (under 8) – Birth Years 2018 and 2019

U6 (under 6) – Birth Years 2020 and 2021

U4 (under 4) – Birth Years 2022 and 2023

There will be PDP (player development teams) competing in the U10 group. This group is made up of players that tried out in May and are interested in the travel program. They are U8-age players.

What is the group code being requested by 360Player?

FRW8F7

How do I sign up?

1. Go to Delmarvarush.com/rec-soccer
2. Click on the blue button for the appropriate age group
3. This will take you to the 360Player platform where you will need an account. If it asks for a group code use: FRW8F7
4. Please answer the questions and finish registration by paying with Visa or MasterCard.

Can my child play in an older division?

In most cases, Delmarva Rush encourages players to play in their appropriate age group. A request to play up can be submitted to info@delmarvarush.com and will be reviewed for approval.

Will my child have a team practice during the week?

All teams U8 and older will have a team practice once a week. The practice day will be picked by the coach. We cannot move players to another team if they are unable to make the practice date picked by the coach.

Will the players get uniforms?

Players will receive a jersey prior to their first game. Players are required to provide their own shorts, shin guards, soccer cleats, a soccer ball and knee-high socks that cover the shin guards.

What size soccer ball does my child need?

U4 – U6: Size 3

U8 – U12: Size 4

U15: Size 5

What should I expect the first day of the season?

Parents should expect to arrive early to meet with their teams and collect their jersey from their coach at their assigned field. There is no check-in process. You will go directly to your assigned field. Assigned fields will be posted on our website at www.delmarvarush.com/rec-soccer prior to the first game. There will also be a whiteboard at the field's pavilion with field assignments. All fields are labeled with signs.
