Position Summary

The Extended Day Teaching Assistant provides a safe, nurturing, and engaging after-school environment for students enrolled in the Extended Day Program at St. Bernard's Catholic School. Working under the direction of the Principal, the Teaching Assistant supervises students during after-school activities, supports homework completion, facilitates age-appropriate recreation, and helps foster a positive, faith-filled atmosphere that reflects the mission and values of Catholic education.

This is a part-time hourly position scheduled Monday through Friday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. during the regular school year.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Supervise students enrolled in the Extended Day Program in a safe, caring, and respectful environment.
- Model and promote Catholic values, Christian kindness, and Gospel-centered behavior in all interactions with students, families, and staff.
- Welcome students into the program following dismissal and ensure accurate attendance.
- Supervise daily snack time while maintaining appropriate health and safety practices.
- Provide a structured homework period by encouraging responsibility, organization, and independent learning.
- Supervise indoor and outdoor free play, games, and recreational activities appropriate for elementary-aged children.
- Monitor student behavior using positive guidance and consistent expectations.
- Maintain a clean, organized, and orderly Extended Day environment.
- Communicate student concerns, injuries, behavioral issues, or other significant information to the principal and parents as appropriate.
- Ensure students are released only to authorized adults according to school procedures.
- Follow all school safety protocols, emergency procedures, and diocesan policies.
- Attend required staff meetings and training as assigned.
- Perform other duties related to the Extended Day Program as assigned by the principal.

Qualifications

- Experience working with children in a school, childcare, recreation, or similar setting is preferred. Candidates should demonstrate patience, reliability, sound judgment, and a genuine enjoyment of working with elementary-aged children.
- Applicants must successfully complete all required diocesan safe environment training and pass a Diocese of Crookston background check prior to employment.

- Dependable, punctual, and able to work independently while following established procedures.
