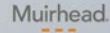
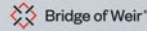

4. In the event of the show being cancelled, no refunds will be given.
5. All ponies/horses attending the show must have a valid passport which must be brought to the show in order to comply with Government regulations.
6. All competitors should have their own insurance, including third party liability and personal accident cover.
7. Organisers and landowners will not hold themselves responsible for any accident or injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever or however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry to the showground that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action from any such incident.
8. All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years and over.
9. The following behaviours will result in elimination from class/show, without refund of entry fees: ill-treatment of a horse or pony; irresponsible/dangerous behaviour, handling or riding; inappropriate/over-use of a whip; any behaviour which is not in accordance with the Rules of Competition or general etiquette.
10. All horses and ponies must be in acceptable condition.
11. All mounted riders must wear their numbers at all times.
12. All mounted riders must wear protective head gear which fits correctly, is correctly fastened at all times, is solid and unbroken and must conform to current standards. Official Stewards/Organisers may eliminate a competitor riding at the show without a hat or with the chinstrap unfastened or with a hat that does not comply with these standards.
13. The Committee reserve the right to substitute other judges for those named. Judges' decisions are final.
