Vision Screenings at Caridad Center

On June 14, we joined the team at Caridad Center in Boynton Beach to provide free vision screenings for children in need.

We screened 59 children, and 37% were referred for additional care. Many of these kids had never had an eye exam before—some were found to have significant vision issues that, left untreated, could have led to permanent loss. Early detection matters—and you helped make it possible.
