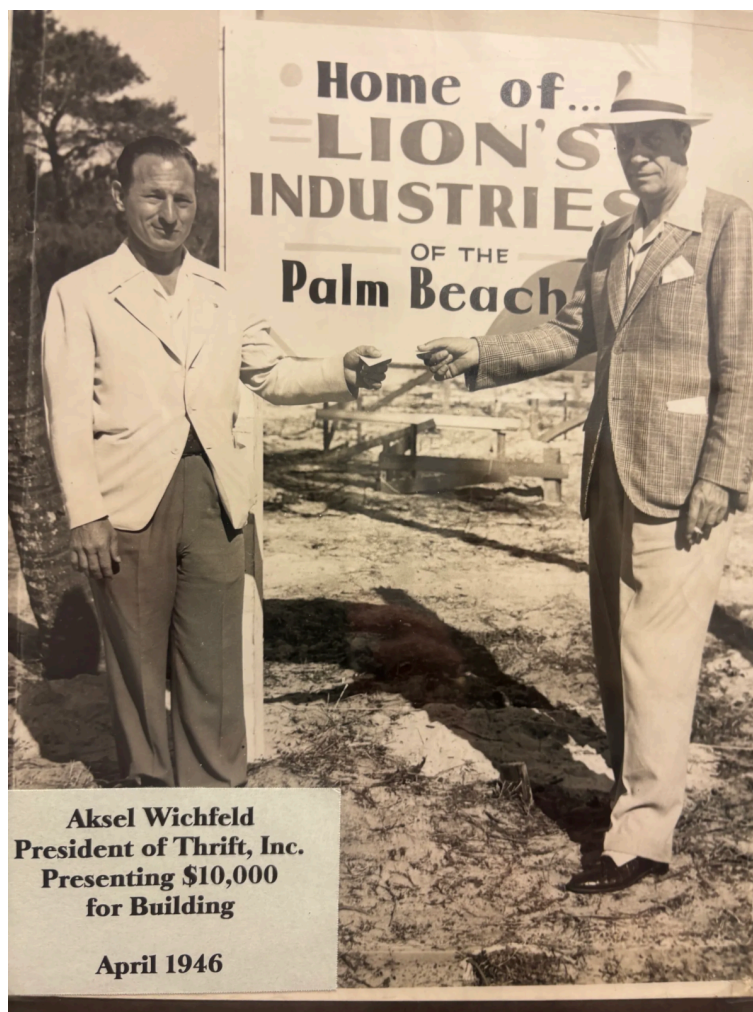

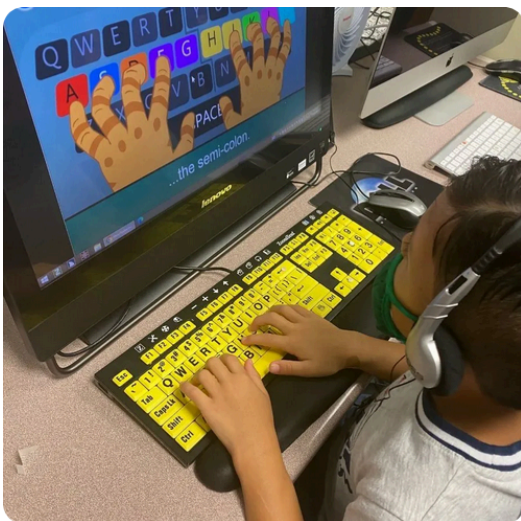

Your gently used tech can transform a life. Lighthouse provides smartphones, computers, and accessibility equipment to individuals with visual impairments who cannot afford them.

- Accepted items include CCTVs, magnifiers, braille devices, computers, and iOS/Android devices
- Donations are tax-deductible
- Help someone connect, learn, and live more fully

Ways to Support Lighthouse for the Blind

Donating Appreciated Stocks, Securities and Bonds

- Deduct the full fair-market value of appreciated assets held for over a year
- Avoid paying capital gains tax on the appreciation
- Any unused deduction can be carried forward for up to five years

Giving from Your IRA

- If you're 70 1/2 or older with an IRA you can transfer up to \$108,000 each year to the Lighthouse for the Blind
- This can count toward your yearly required minimum distribution

Donor Advised Funds (DAF)

The end of the year is a great time to make an impact with your DAF. Some benefits with your DAF -
