

Kalasho Education and Youth Services (KEYS) is a health and family services nonprofit that serves as the central hub for a dynamic network of mission-driven organizations and municipalities. As the backbone entity, Kalasho Education and Youth operates out of a completely unique, state-of-the-art MINDgarden center in Warren. Remarkably, this flagship facility was renovated at a fraction of the cost of comparable centers demonstrating their commitment to innovation, stewardship, and community-centered design.

In addition to providing direct services, Kalasho Education and Youth Services works closely with partner organizations and local governments to coordinate strategy, operations, and shared infrastructure. This collaborative approach significantly reduces administrative overhead while maximizing impact at scale.



The Kalasho Education and Youth network of services employs more than **275 professionals**, and reaches thousands of families each year with responsive, culturally competent programming.

Every day, they help facilitate in the making and delivery of meals for **14,600 children**, while striving to ensure that families use available resources to move toward financial independence. By aligning essential services under one coordinated vision, Kalasho Education and Youth Services ensures individuals and families don't just receive care, they thrive.
