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Dear Parish Family,

This weekend we hear, from the 1st Book of Kings, Solomon's tremendous honesty, "O Lord, my God, you have made me, your servant, king to succeed my father David; but I am a mere youth, not knowing at all how to act..." (1 Ki 3:5, 7-12). The humility from King Solomon is admirable. The Lord appeared to King Solomon and all that he asked for was wisdom and an understanding heart to lead his people.

There are a few things for us to ponder and learn from this encounter of Solomon with the Lord. Solomon was not full of himself, he had the good of others in mind and he knew the tremendous responsibility that was demanded of him. The Lord was pleased with his request and blessed him abundantly, beyond what he could have imagined. Solomon knew that the task before him was beyond his capacity. His reliance upon the Lord, his humility at acknowledging his limitations and his trust in the Lord is something for us to sit and ponder in prayer.

There were so many things Solomon could have asked for himself but he chose something for the good of others. We are invited to learn from Solomon and his attitude today. Jesus wants to save the whole world beginning with you and me. The Church exists for the salvation of souls and it is our task to spread the fire of the Father's love upon our families, parishes and city! We are being asked by the Lord to look beyond ourselves and our perspective, to rely upon Him. There is a concern in the heart of Jesus for the salvation of souls, catholics and non-catholics. Our mission is to come to the Lord Jesus, to ask Him to empower us so that you and I can lead others to Him, bring souls to our savior.

The goal of our parish linkage is to strengthen our communities and to combine some of our resources so that we can be more effective in reaching souls for Christ. In our own communities we have empty pews and families that no longer come. Have we talked to the Lord about it? Are we concerned for their and our salvation? Have we asked the Lord to give us what we need to bring them back to full communion with Him? Empty churches are not just the problem of the priest. It is a problem for us all; not because we should have full churches, but because the Lord Jesus is longing for each and everyone of these souls. Psychologists tell us that we experience what we focus on. Is Jesus Christ our main focus in the Church? In our own interior lives, is Jesus our priority? I pray and hope that we may become humble like Solomon and rely upon Him to bring the fire of His love to all whom we know. There is no doubt our churches will be full if our number one priority is Jesus Christ.

Este fin de semana escuchamos, del Primer Libro de Reyes, la tremenda honestidad de Salomón: "Oh Señor, Dios mío, tú has hecho a tu siervo rey en lugar de mi padre David; pero yo soy un muchacho, y no sé cómo actuar..." (1 Re 3:5, 7-12). La humildad del rey Salomón es admirable. El Señor se apareció al rey Salomón y todo lo que pidió fue sabiduría y un corazón comprensivo para guiar a su pueblo.

Hay algunas cosas para que meditemos y aprendamos de este encuentro de Salomón con el Señor. Salomón no estaba lleno de egoísmos, tenía en mente el bien de los demás y sabía la tremenda responsabilidad que tenía. El Señor quedó complacido con su petición y lo bendijo abundantemente, más de lo que él podía imaginar. Salomón sabía que la tarea que tenía por delante estaba más allá de su capacidad. Su confianza en el Señor, su humildad al reconocer su limitaciones y su confianza en el Señor son algo para que nos sentemos a meditar en oración.

Había tantas cosas que Salomón podría haber pedido para sí mismo, pero eligió algo para el bien de los demás. Hoy estamos invitados a aprender de Salomón y de su actitud. Jesús quiere salvar al mundo entero, comenzando por ti y por mí. ¡La Iglesia existe para la salvación de las almas, y nuestra tarea es difundir el fuego del amor del Padre sobre nuestras familias, parroquias y ciudad! El Señor nos pide que miremos más allá de nosotros mismos y de nuestra propia perspectiva, para confiar en Él. Hay una preocupación en el corazón de Jesús por la salvación de las almas, católicos y no católicos. Nuestra misión es acudir al Señor Jesús, pedirle que nos capacite para que tú y yo podamos llevar a otros hacia Él, traer almas a nuestro salvador.

El objetivo de nuestra vinculación parroquial es fortalecer nuestras comunidades y combinar algunos de nuestros recursos para ser más efectivos en obtener almas para Cristo. En nuestras propias comunidades tenemos bancas vacías y familias que ya no vienen. ¿Hemos hablado con el Señor al respecto? ¿Nos preocupa la salvación de ellos y la nuestra? ¿Le hemos pedido al Señor que nos dé lo necesario para traerlos de vuelta a la comunión plena con Él? Las iglesias vacías no son solo un problema del sacerdote. Es un problema de todos nosotros; no porque debamos tener iglesias llenas, sino porque el Señor Jesús anhela a cada una de estas almas. Los psicólogos nos dicen que experimentamos aquello en lo que nos enfocamos. ¿Es Jesucristo nuestro enfoque principal en la Iglesia? En nuestra propia vida interior, ¿es Jesús nuestra prioridad? Ruego y espero que podamos llegar a ser humildes como Salomón y confiar en Él para traer el fuego de su amor a todos los que conocemos. No hay duda de que nuestras iglesias estarán llenas si nuestra prioridad número uno es Jesucristo.
