Hopefully you will notice the installation of the new taller gates at the entrance to the playground. We have also had new gates installed on the field to replace the low gate that was previously in place, enhancing our security measures.

Staffing

We extend a warm welcome to our new member of staff this term, Mrs Vicky Butterfield who will be the new class teacher in Magdalene Class. We welcome her to our team and our wonderful school community.

As part of the new Early Years framework, new legislation comes into place in September 2025. The majority of what is being enforced is already in place in our school. All staff in our school are Paediatric first aid trained as well as completing First aid at work and for our Forest school leaders, a forest school first aid qualification is also in place.

Children in pre-school may only be offered water or milk as providers will need to follow new nutrition guidance (unless there's a good reason not to) which emphasizes healthy, balanced, and nutritious meals, snacks, and drink.

As part of this legislation Paediatric first aid trained staff must have eyes on the younger children when eating due to choking hazards. Therefore, at breaktime to ensure this is manageable we will be asking <u>all</u> children to sit and eat their snack (if they have one) before playing. Please can we emphasize that this should be a healthy snack if provided from home. Fruit is available for reception and Keys stage one children. At lunchtime all Pre-school children and reception will be positioned so an adult has eye contact with each one of them.

For Pre-school parents our school absence policy will be in place and we ask that the same protocols are followed for pre-school children as our school pupils. An attendance letter has been included with this newsletter which relates to if a child is unable to attend a pre-school session. The expectation is that parents will inform the Pre-school/ School by 9am on each day of absence.



Please ensure children have the correct PE Kit in school for these sessions. A reminder that PE kit is black shorts or jogging bottoms and a red T-shirt and sweatshirt. Children must have a change of shoes for PE.



Please ensure children wear the correct school uniform of black or grey trousers/ skirts/ pinafore, white or red polo shirts or shirts and a red cardigan or sweatshirt, **Plain black** school shoes or trainers. Please refrain from permitting the children from wearing dangling hair accessories as these could get caught whilst playing. Long hair should be tied up. One pair of studded earrings are permitted but must be removed for PE and dance. If your child is unable to remove their earrings for PE please do this for them before they come into school. A reminder to name all items of clothing so we can return to the right child when lost.

Asthma inhalers

Please ensure that if your child has asthma or an inhaler prescribed by the doctor that the inhalers are in school with an original label on, a spacer is provided and you have completed an up to date asthma form.
