New Maths Program

We are using a new program to teach maths in our school from this term called 'Can Do maths' from reception to Year 6. At the moment Pre-School will continue to use 'master the Curriculum.'

It is teaching that focuses on developing secure and deep understanding, including the use of practical resources and iconic representations which supports the learning and memorisation of mathematical concepts.

We did trial this at the end of the last term and it was extremely successful so we look forward to moving forward with this exciting new program.
