## Membership

- The current membership badge must be worn on the 25<sup>th</sup> October and at any out meetings. Members not adhering to this will be asked to leave the procession and will not be permitted into the firesite.
- Membership is open to all adults and juniors. All new membership applications must be proposed & seconded by 2 members and subject to committee approval.
- All members will pay an annual subscription, which will be discussed at the AGM.
  The recommendations of the AGM will be considered by the Committee before setting the rate of Annual subscriptions for the forthcoming year.
- The Society may refuse or terminate membership without reason.
- The Society cannot accept liability for any injury to members or visitors partaking in Society functions.
- Officers and Members of the Society will at all times act in a responsible and safe manner and must not bring the Society into disrepute. This also applies to Committee members and all Members attending out-meetings. Anyone not adhering to these rules will be referred to the Executive Committee for a disciplinary judgment.
- Should any Member of the Society have cause for complaint, a copy of the Society's Grievance Procedure may be obtained from the Secretary.

## Walking in processions

Wear your membership badge in a prominent position; failure to wear your badge will result in being asked to leave the procession.

Walk in orderly ranks of three; one member on each side of the road and one in the middle. This is how the Society looks at its best, and it allows torch and other marshals to move about the procession with ease.

Junior members must always be under the supervision of a parent or responsible adult.

Juniors should always be positioned in the middle of a rank.

Maintain a distance of at least 3 metres from the rank in front of you.

Do not light the torch until instructed to do so; do not throw it away once lit until it is spent.

Always take care with your torch, especially around firework pieces, flaming banners and bands.

Although it is left to the supervising adult as to whether or not a child should carry a torch, if marshals feel that the child is not comfortable or is seen as a danger to other members, their torch will be removed.
