PROGRESS AT FARMINGTON CROSSINGS



Plans are in place to close Bray Road in Farmington periodically, due to ongoing construction at Farmington Crossings.

Temporary closures are necessary to allow for construction activities associated with the development. Drivers are encouraged to watch for detour signs and use caution when traveling through the area, as workers and equipment may be present.

Plans include adding a three-lane section near the development. Access will remain open for local traffic throughout the construction.

There is no set schedule for the closures, and traffic disruptions will occur as construction activities require. Drivers should expect intermittent closures over the coming months.

Farmington Yard Waste Disposal Site

Did you know, the City of Farmington operates a yard waste disposal site that is available to all City residents?

The site is open daily from 7:00am to 7:00pm at 3875 Pimville Road in Farmington, approximately one mile west of Bray Road.

The Yard Waste Site is for use by residents living inside the City limits of Farmington only, and no commercial disposal is permitted.

Leaves, limbs, grass clippings, and other yard waste are accepted. Residents are asked to please remove plastic or paper bags when dropping items off at the site.

Mulch resulting from yard waste site operations is available for free to City residents and may be picked up during regular hours.

Residents should note that the available mulch is coarse mulch, not standard retail mulch.
