MANAGING UTILITY BILLS THIS FALL AND WINTER



Fall and winter often bring higher utility bills. When temperatures are low, electricity use increases due to higher heating needs.

The larger the difference in temperature inside your house versus outside, the more energy you will use to heat your home.

One way to manage seasonal spikes is through Budget Billing, which provides a consistent monthly payment based on your average usage. To sign up, visit the Farmington City Light & Water office or call 573-756-2620.
