<p><i>Five Acre School -provides a child-centered learning environment that fosters the growth of the whole child in relationship to each other, our community and the natural world.</i></p> <p>Five Acre School is a small independent school located adjacent to the Dungeness Recreation Area that serves preschool through 6th grade students. We provide a caring and flexible educational program emphasizing a child-centered approach. The educational philosophy is to educate the whole person and promote personal responsibility and accountability. We are looking for a friendly, confident, adaptable, and team oriented lead teacher for our Summer care program. This teacher will work with school leadership to learn the culture and curricular systems in place at Five Acre School and to explore ways to bring their unique skills and voice into the program.</p> <p>ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide a safe and welcoming environment ● Supervise students in the play yard and classroom ● Prepare activities (games, manipulatives, projects) for a 6 hour program ● Lead daily hikes in the adjacent Dungeness National Wildlife Refuge ● Supervise lunch and recess ● Clean up at the conclusion of the program ● Keep attendance records for the program ● Communicate with families and other staff, when needed ● Lock up the school when leaving <p>QUALIFICATIONS, SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Experience working with pre K and K- 6th grade children ● Have an understanding of and commitment to Five Acre School’s mission, vision and values ● Have an ability to communicate and connect with a diverse population of students, staff, and parents ● Are dedicated to nurturing young children and have experience with child centered curriculum and social emotional learning ● Have knowledge about early childhood and school age development ● Have current or be willing to acquire CPR/First Aid Training ● Participate in and pass school-wide trainings that include, but are not limited to: mandatory reporter, sexual-harassment, keeping schools safe, social media safety, preventing sexual activity in children ● Able and willing to walk while carrying a 10lb+ backpack, 3-5 miles in a day for hikes and outdoor activities. ● Able to lift 20lbs. ● Able to sit on the floor for extended periods of time. <p>ADDITIONAL NOTES</p> <p>Pay will be dependent on experience.
