

In Loving Memory of Rosalie Guajardo Obregon September 8, 1925 - March 2, 2024

Julia Rosalie Guajardo Obregon, beloved wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother passed away peacefully of natural causes at The Village of Incarnate Word Retirement Center..

Rose, as she liked to be called, was born September 8, 1925 in Files Valley Texas to Lorenzo M. Guajardo and Eduvijes Trevino Guajardo.

She was a resident of Houston in West University Place and San Antonio Texas, Alamo Heights. She lived the last 12 years in San Antonio to be close to her two daughters, Olga Gately and Sylvia Jaye.
