1. What do we do?

- Manage the Gullane recreation hall that is leased from the EL council. The building is used by various community groups to deliver classes to locals. It is also hired by the general public for private functions, local and health authorities for public events.
- Work with local groups to support their efforts e.g. primary school, Gullane Bloomers
- Provide input to large forums affecting life in the village e.g. GACC, NBCAP, ELC
- Create & distribute GVA newsletter regularly. A '*what's going on in the village*' created from inputs from the Gullane community. This glossy 20-pager newsletter is distributed to all Gullane households, businesses and local service providers (circa 1700 copies) by GVA volunteers.
- Run local events every 2 months where guest speakers are invited to contribute on a selected topic, often one that has been requested by GVA members.
- Run 2 larger dedicated events; a whole day children Easter event and a week-end long Artisan Fair where traders come to exhibit and sell their wares.
- Raise funds for projects to enhance the village neighbourhood, example being provisioning of belly bins for more effective rubbish management
- Create and deliver classes e.g. sewing classes
- Identify local needs and support providers meet these needs e.g. chair yoga classes
