

## **Laganvale Farm Tearoom/ Kitchen Assistant**

### **Description of the Role:**

The Linen Tearoom is part of Laganvale Farm, an open farm and indoor play centre venue. We serve breakfasts, light lunches and hot drinks. We require a hard-working, reliable person to work mainly in our kitchen both in the preparation of food and maintenance of cleanliness and hygiene. A team player with initiative and drive who will respect our values and objectives at Laganvale Farm.

### **Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Washing dishes and loading/ unloading dishwasher.
- Assisting with preparation of ingredients – chopping vegetables, grating cheese, cooking meats, etc.
- Assisting in kitchen with preparation and prompt service of customer orders.
- Maintaining a high standard of cleanliness throughout the tearoom – kitchen area, customer areas and back room areas. This will include brushing and mopping floors, cleaning surfaces, dealing with spills, emptying bins, etc.
- Adhering to company and government health and hygiene procedures
- Ensuring all food and other items are stored appropriately

### **Requirements**

- Preference for at least 6 month's proven experience in a similar position e.g. cafe or sandwich bar
- Able to follow instruction from kitchen manager but also show initiative for tasks needing completed without constant supervision
- Able to cope with multi-tasking – e.g. switching between kitchen, cleaning/clearing duties and occasional counter service if required
- Willingness to lend a hand across other areas of the farm if needed e.g. helping colleagues in the indoor play or farm/barn areas if needed
- Flexibility and excellent team-working and communication skills

### **Hours & Pay:**

The farm is normally open Wednesday to Saturday each week and cover will be required from 9.00am to 4.30pm each day. There may be some flexibility on the days/hours of work within these requirements depending on the applications received for the post(s). The rate of pay will be in line with National Minimum Wage.

The post(s) will initially be temporary for 3 months with a possibility of permanent employment and/or further seasonal hours.
