**Today we celebrate the Third** Sunday of Advent! The pink candle in the Advent wreath symbolizes "REJOICE." The second reading from James calls us to be patient and uses the analogy of a farmer who waits for the seeds to grow patiently and for the rain in both spring and fall in order to achieve the yield needed for survival. We, as followers of Jesus, must be patient also. In today's Gospel, John sends a message to Jesus from jail asking if He is the Messiah – the anointed one? Jesus' response to John the Baptist is that Jesus is demonstrating to all that He IS the anointed one. What can we do to prepare our hearts for the coming of the Lord? How can we demonstrate patience with our children, parents, friends, relatives, co-workers, etc. Take time to pray...
