Looking Back... Looking Forward

“Abide in my love.”
— John 15:9

Over the past several weeks, we have reflected on what it means to live as Christian stewards through the lens of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Beginning with our consecration to His Sacred Heart, we discovered that stewardship is not simply about what we give, it is about how we live.

Together we reflected that:

- Everything is gift.
- Time is a sacred gift entrusted to us.
- Our talents are meant to be shared in service to others.
- Generosity flows from hearts that trust in Christ.

At the center of every reflection was the same invitation: to allow the Heart of Jesus to shape our own.

The Sacred Heart teaches us that love always gives. Jesus poured Himself out completely for our salvation, and He continues to give Himself to us in the Eucharist. Our response is not merely gratitude, it is a life offered back to Him.

As St. Ignatius prayed:
"Take, Lord, receive all my liberty, my memory, my understanding, and my entire will... All is Yours."

May those words continue to become the prayer of our own hearts.

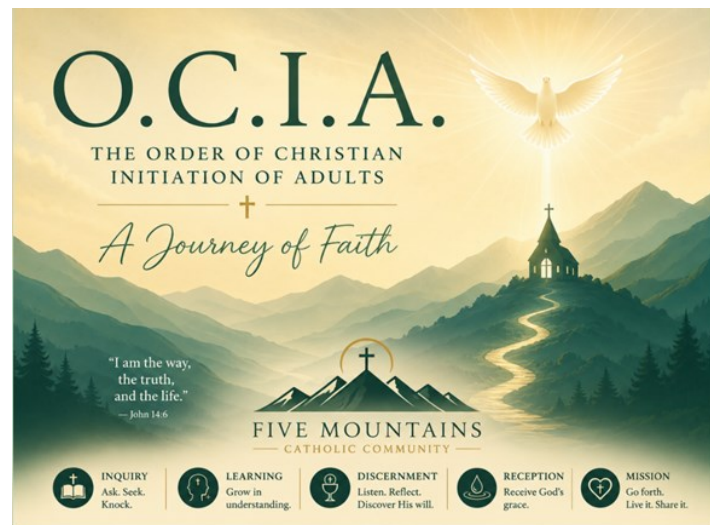
Attendees will discover the importance of contemplation by creating space to slow down and listen. Through prayer and reflection, they will learn how to deepen their awareness of God's presence.
