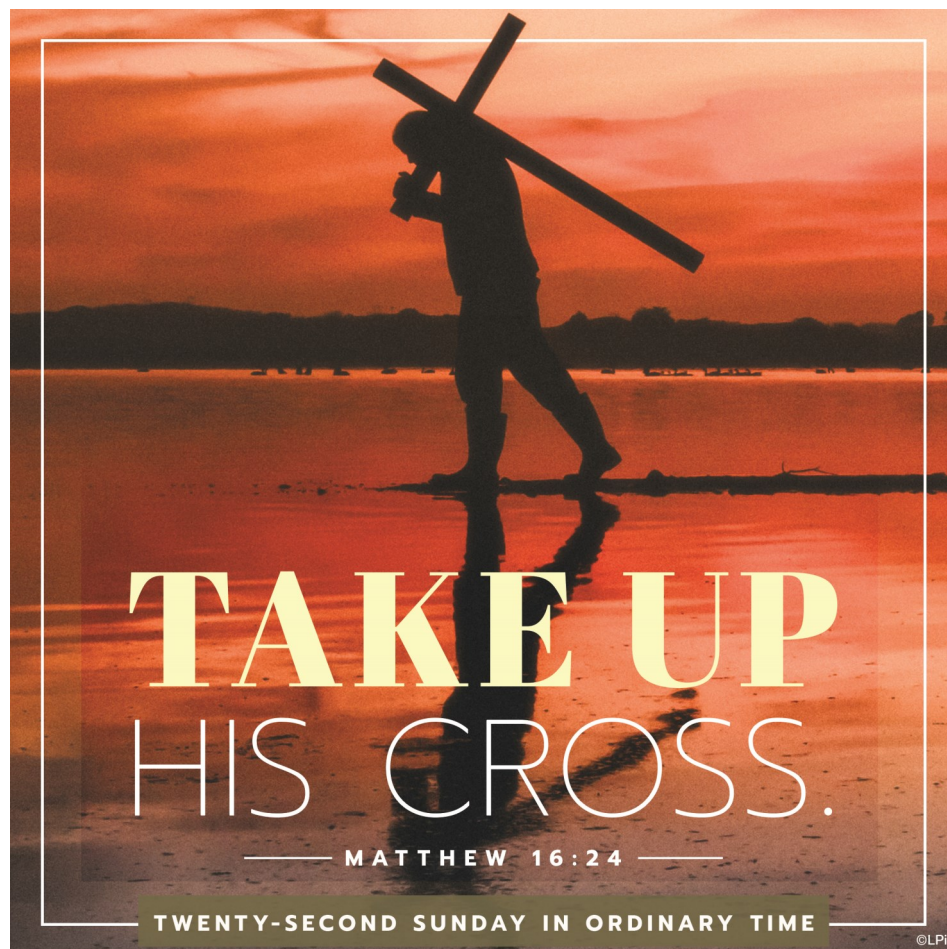

CHAPTER 4 ~ The Heart That Reveals God

Heart of Jesus, Substantially United to the Word of God

“And the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.”

John 1:14

He did not remain distant.

He did not simply send a message from heaven.

The Word became flesh.

The fourth invocation of the Litany brings us to the very heart of this mystery:

Heart of Jesus, substantially united to the Word of God.

This changes the way we understand discipleship.

Following Jesus is not simply about learning a set of teachings or trying to become a better person. It is about entering into a relationship with the One who reveals the very heart of God.

And Jesus does not keep that love for Himself.

Throughout the Gospels, we see Him notice people others overlook, welcome those who feel excluded, forgive those who have fallen, heal those who suffer, and give Himself completely for others.

This is the Heart we are invited to imitate.

Stewardship begins to make sense when we see it through this Heart. God does not give simply so that we can possess. He gives so that His gifts may become a blessing to others.

Our time can become an expression of love.
Our talents can become a way of serving.

Our resources can become a means of generosity.

Even our presence can become a gift when someone simply needs to know they are not alone.

Our Parish Family is strengthened in the same way. We each bring different gifts and experiences, but those gifts become most meaningful when they are offered for the good of others.

Jesus shows us that love is never meant to remain within us. It is received, and then given.

The Word became flesh so that we could encounter the love of God.

And now, through our lives, Christ invites that love to become visible in the world.

Living the Heart This Week

Pray - Read John 1:14 slowly. Ask Jesus: “What do You want me to see about Your love?”

At Home - Choose one small way to make God's love visible in your home this week—a kind word, an act of patience, or simply giving someone your full attention.

In Our Parish Family - Look for someone who may feel unnoticed or alone at Mass. A smile, a greeting, or a simple conversation can be a powerful act of welcome.

Beyond Our Doors - Ask yourself: “What gift has God given me that could become a blessing to someone else?” Then find one opportunity to share it.

A Heart to Remember

What we receive from the Heart of Jesus is never meant to stop with us; it is meant to become a gift to others.

Prayer

Jesus, Word made flesh, thank You for coming close to us and revealing the Father's love. Open our eyes to recognize Your presence and our hearts to share the love we have received. May our lives become a visible reflection of Your Heart in our homes, our Parish Family, and our world.

Heart of Jesus, make our hearts more like Yours. Amen.
