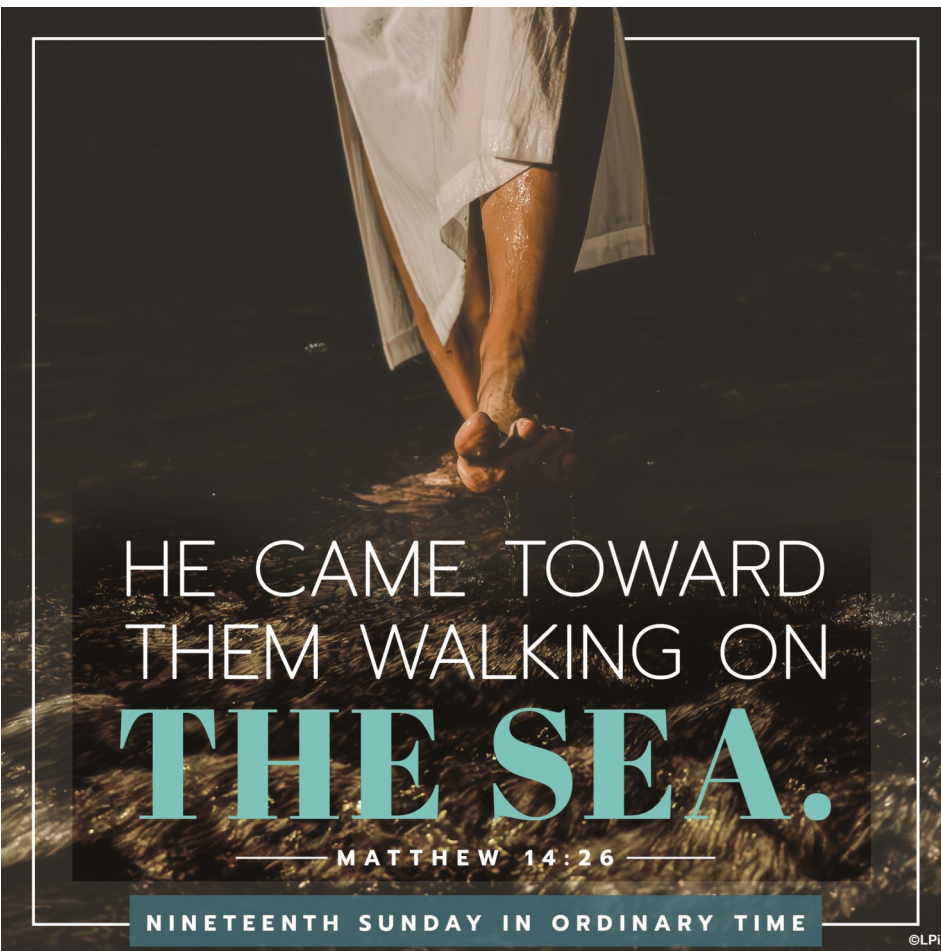

CHAPTER 1 ~ Come and See *"Come, and you will see." — John 1:39* **An Invitation to the Journey**

"Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, 'What are you looking for?' They said to him, 'Rabbi, where are you staying?' He said to them, 'Come, and you will see.'"
John 1:38–39

Every journey begins with an invitation. For the first disciples, that invitation came from Jesus Himself. They did not yet know where He would lead them or how their lives would change. They simply accepted His invitation: **"Come and see."**

That same invitation is extended to each of us today.

Over the coming weeks, we will journey together through the **Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus**, discovering one invocation at a time. Each title reveals something about the Heart of Christ and invites us to know Him more deeply. As we come to know His Heart, He gently transforms our own.

This journey is about more than learning a beautiful prayer. It is about allowing the Sacred Heart of Jesus to shape the way we live.

We begin to see prayer not as an obligation, but as a conversation with the One who loves us. Stewardship becomes more than sharing our time, talent, and treasure; it becomes a grateful response to God's many blessings. Discipleship becomes more than believing in Jesus, it becomes following Him each day with trust and generosity.

This is also a journey we take together.

Though we worship in different churches and come from many backgrounds and experiences, we are united as **our parish family** through one Baptism, one Eucharist, and one Lord. The Sacred Heart calls us not only into a deeper relationship with Christ, but also into a deeper relationship with one another.

No matter where you are on your faith journey, whether your faith feels strong or you're searching for a deeper connection, you are welcome here. Jesus continues to extend the same invitation He offered His first disciples.

"Come and see."

May these weekly reflections help each of us discover that the Heart of Jesus is not only to be honored but also imitated. As we grow closer to Him, may our hearts become more compassionate, more generous, and more faithful.

The journey begins today.

Will you accept His invitation?

Living the Heart This Week

Pray: Begin each morning by praying: "Jesus, help me to know Your Heart more deeply today."

At Home: Read John 1:35–39. Imagine Jesus looking at you and saying, "Come and see." What might He be inviting you to discover?

In Our Parish Family: Introduce yourself to someone you have not met before or reconnect with someone you haven't seen in a while. Every parish family grows stronger through simple acts of welcome.

Beyond Our Doors: Invite someone to join you at Mass, a parish event, or simply for a conversation about faith.

A Heart to Remember

Every journey of faith begins with one simple invitation from Jesus: "Come and see."

Sacred Heart of Jesus, thank You for inviting us to walk with You. Open our hearts to Your love as we begin this journey together. Teach us to trust You more deeply, to live with grateful hearts, and to reflect Your love in our homes, our parish family, and our daily lives.

Heart of Jesus, make our hearts more like Yours. Amen.

SACRAMENTS

ANOIDING OF THE SICK:

Catholics are encouraged to request the sacrament prior to surgery, for extended illnesses or in emergency situations. Please contact your parish office to make arrangements for the priest to confer this sacrament. *While a priest will always do everything in his power to come, if you have a loved one who is in their final days, please do not wait until the last moment to call for Anointing.* We want to ensure that there is adequate time for your loved one to receive the sacrament.

COMMUNION TO SICK AND HOMEBOUND:

Please contact your parish office to make arrangements to have Communion brought to your loved ones who are unable to attend Mass.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION:

Baptism, infant: Parents or guardians wishing to have a child less than seven years of age baptized are required to participate in preparation classes. We encourage preparation before the birth of the child.

Marriage: Couples seeking marriage must meet with the pastor at least six months in advance of the planned marriage date. A specific date can be set only after initial preparation has been completed.

If you have a request for needed prayers, strength, hope, courage or thanksgiving for yourself, family or friends, or if you would like to join the prayer chain and help with calls please contact your parish office.



Question:

Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Answer:

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

Registration at the 5 churches of Family 44 can be done on each churches website or in person. Look for the forms in the pews or the vestibule.

CHANGES: Please advise the parish office of any change of address, telephone number, email, or if you are moving out of the parish.

ENVELOPES: The churches of Family 44 are totally dependent on the generosity of parishioners for support. The use of envelopes, regardless of the amount of the contribution, make possible our parish activities and services.

CONSIDER ELECTRONIC GIVING: Each church offers a convenient electronic giving option that allows donations to be made one time or on a scheduled basis. Visit our websites and sign up today.

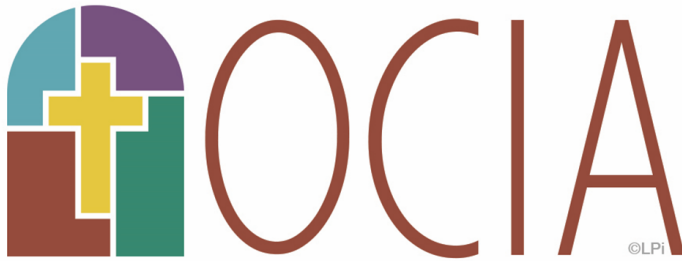

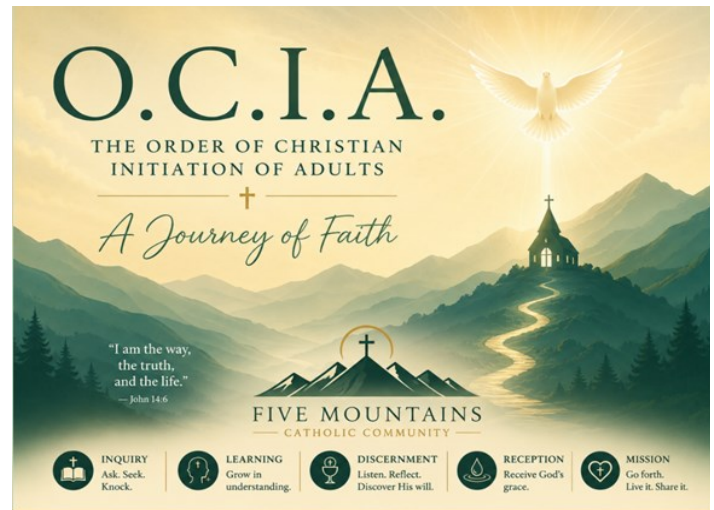

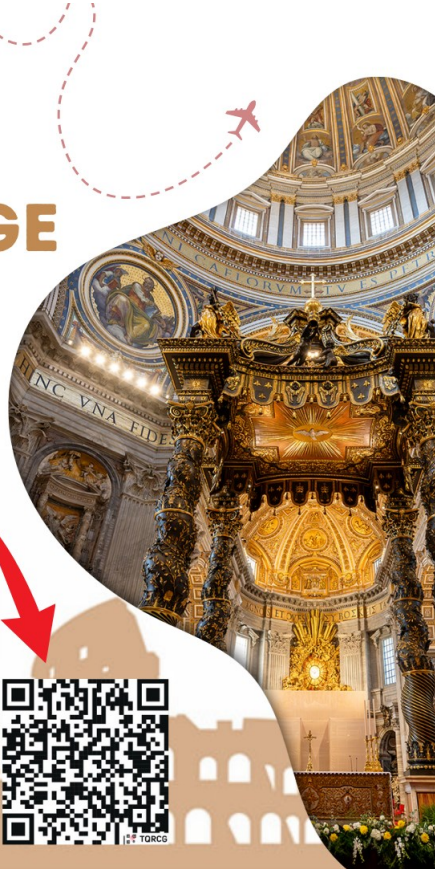
