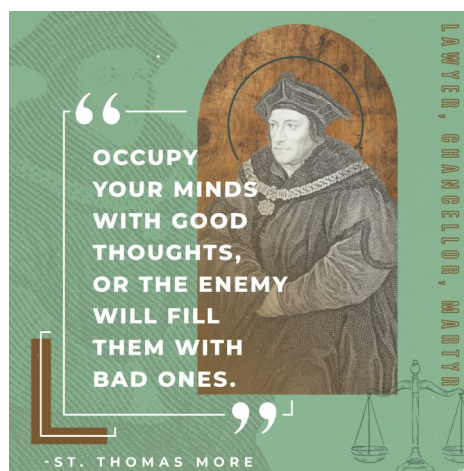

UPDATE

Parish Families Mark Two Years of Coming Together

July marks the conclusion of the second year of 136 parishes working together as 60 parish families across the Archdiocese of Seattle. This is part of the [Partners in the Gospel](#) strategic pastoral planning effort, which is rooted in the goal of re-invigorating parish life.

During the first two years, each parish family began welcoming and getting to know each other, after which they formed two leadership teams with representatives from every parish to help guide parish families through the [One Parish Planning process](#). This process aims at forming one new parish based on the vision and goals of the parish family and is estimated to take about three years to complete, with multiple opportunities for parishioners to engage through listening and community consultation sessions.



To date:

- Nearly 400 parish family listening sessions and consultations have taken place across the archdiocese since parish families formed.
- Around 42% of parish families are currently wrapping up the “Who Are We?” phase of the One Parish Planning process, and 54% are moving into the following phase of planning asking, “Who Do We Want to Become?”
- Many parish family ministry leaders began combining efforts, offering more robust youth programs, engaging faith formation opportunities, joint fellowship events and more volunteers for outreach and service.

From Archbishop Paul D. Etienne

“How can we reorganize and restructure parishes so that we are spending more time reflecting Christ’s radical love rather than trying to preserve the status quo that was designed for a different era?” said Archbishop Paul D. Etienne, in his July 1 letter marking this two-year milestone. “Together, as the people of God, we are courageously re-imagining how to respond to the needs of the world today rather than struggling to maintain a parish structure built for a bygone era.”

STEWARDSHIP SERIES – WEEK 4

“All Is Yours”

Living the Mission

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight.”

— Proverbs 3:5

Over the past several weeks, we have reflected on stewardship as a response to the love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We have recognized that everything is gift, that our time is precious, and that our talents are entrusted to us for the good of others.

Today we bring these reflections together with one final truth:

Everything belongs to God.

Christian stewardship is not simply about what we give. It is about whom we trust.

The Heart That Sends Us Forth

“Freely you have received; freely give.”

— Matthew 10:8

The Sacred Heart of Jesus continually pours out His love upon the world. As disciples, we are called not only to receive that love but also to share it generously.

Whether we offer our time, our talents, our financial resources, our prayers, or simple acts of kindness, every gift becomes an offering of love when placed in Christ's hands.

The measure of stewardship is not the size of the gift, but the generosity of the heart that offers it.

Reflection

St. Ignatius concluded his Suscipe prayer with these words:

“All is Yours; dispose of it wholly according to Your will. Give me only Your love and Your grace; that is enough for me.”

These words express the heart of Christian stewardship.

When we trust the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we discover that His love is enough. We become free to live generously—not from obligation, but from gratitude.

Our treasure, like our time and talents, is a gift entrusted to us for God's purposes. Through our generosity, we support the mission of the Church, care for those in need, and help proclaim the Gospel to future generations.

Living as a Christian steward means asking each day:

“Lord, how can I use all that You have entrusted to me for Your glory?”

Ponder

- Do I trust God with every part of my life?
- Am I generous with the gifts God has entrusted to me?
- How is Christ inviting me to live as His disciple each day?
- What offering is God asking me to place in His hands?

Guided Prayer

Sacred Heart of Jesus,

All that I am and all that I have belongs to You.

Teach me to trust You completely and to live generously in every aspect of my life.

May all I do bring glory to Your name.

Amen.

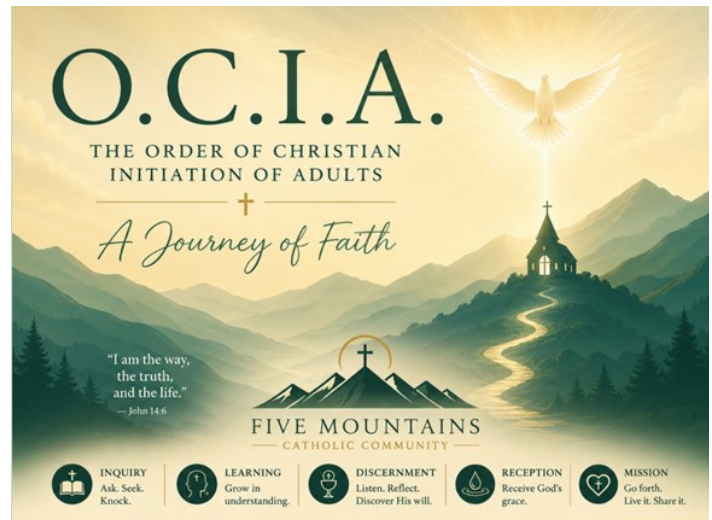

Did you know the domain name for emails received from Parish Family 44 offices will always end in @stjohnnvancouver.org, @sacredheartbg.org, or @stphilipwoodland?



If you receive any emails purported to be from Fr. Temo or any staff, the first thing you need to do, before you even open the email is look at the domain name. If it doesn't show as @stjohnnvancouver.org, @sacredheartbg.org, or @stphilipwoodland, then it isn't from your church.

The new database for the Archdiocese of Seattle domain name is: @ccbchurch.com

This domain specifically relates to the Parishioner Engagement System. This domain is also safe for you to view.

Community Alert of Legal Impersonator

Ways to Identify a false document: "Multiple inconsistencies - including impossible date timelines, incorrect nationality and jurisdiction information, invalid address formatting, missing required licensing details, obvious design flaws, and information not typically found on attorney identification cards - strongly indicate that this ID is fraudulent."



Be Aware of Legal Assistance Scams

Please be aware of a scam targeting families with loved ones in immigration detention. A community member was contacted by someone claiming to be an attorney affiliated with Catholic Services USA. The caller already had personal information about her husband, including his name, date of birth, and place of birth, which made the situation appear legitimate.

The caller used pressure tactics, repeatedly called, created a sense of urgency, and demanded money in order to provide legal representation. After receiving an initial payment, the caller requested even more money and attempted to make the victim feel responsible for her husband's situation. The scam was later confirmed by a trusted source and many other scams have happened using the pretense of working with catholic services USA. If you receive a similar call, independently verify the attorney and organization before sending any money or sharing additional information. Please share this warning with others in the community. Please know that Catholic Services is a legitimate organization that offers multiple services. Be sure to visit them in person or on their verified website before accepting services from anyone claiming to work for them.

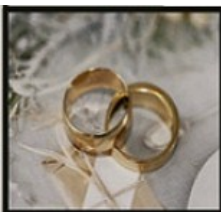
