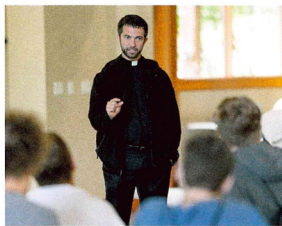

FIVE MOUNTAINS CATHOLIC COMMUNITY ~ STEWARDSHIP

Five Mountains Catholic Community *“Take, Lord, Receive”* *A Prayer of Total Stewardship*



One of the most beautiful prayers of surrender in the Catholic tradition is the prayer known as the Suscipe, Latin for “Receive.” Written by St. Ignatius of Loyola as part of his Spiritual Exercises, this prayer has inspired generations of Christians to place their entire lives into God’s hands.

Many Catholics know it today through the hymn Take, Lord, Receive by the St. Louis Jesuits. Its gentle melody and simple words invite us into a deep prayer of trust and surrender:

***“Take, Lord, receive all my liberty,
my memory, understanding, and my entire will...”***

This prayer beautifully expresses the heart of Christian stewardship. Stewardship is not merely about donating money or volunteering our time. At its deepest level, stewardship is a way of life rooted in gratitude, recognizing that everything we are and everything we have comes from God and ultimately belongs to Him.

The prayer reminds us that even the most personal parts of ourselves, our freedom, thoughts, memories, talents, desires, and future, are gifts entrusted to us by the Lord. The Spiritual Exercises teaches that true peace is found not in controlling our lives, but in placing them completely in God’s care.

St. Ignatius understood that surrender is not weakness; it is trust. It is choosing God’s will over our own because we believe His plans are greater than anything we could design for ourselves. This echoes the words of the prophet Isaiah:

***“For my thoughts are not your thoughts,
nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord.”***
— *Isaiah 55:8*

The prayer continues:
***“All that I have and possess,
You have given all to me.
To You, O Lord, I return it.”***

These words challenge us to reflect honestly on how we use the gifts God has entrusted to us. Do we offer Him only what is left over, or do we place our whole lives at His service? Christian stewardship asks us to return our gifts to God through prayer, generosity, service, and love of neighbor.

This spirit of surrender is seen throughout Scripture. In Proverbs we hear:

***“Trust in the Lord with all your heart,
and do not rely on your own understanding.”***
— *Proverbs 3:5*

And in the Gospel, Jesus Himself models perfect surrender in the Garden of Gethsemane:

“Father... not my will but Yours be done.”
— *Luke 22:42*

Jesus teaches us that surrender to the Father is not passive resignation, but active trust born from love. Stewardship calls us to live with that same openness — allowing God to shape our decisions, priorities, relationships, and use of time and resources.

Perhaps the most powerful line of the prayer is:

***“Give me only Your love and Your grace;
that is enough for me.”***

In a world that constantly tells us we need more, more success, more possessions, more recognition, this prayer reminds us that God alone is sufficient. His grace sustains us. His love fulfills us. When we truly believe this, we become freer to live generously, serve joyfully, and give sacrificially.

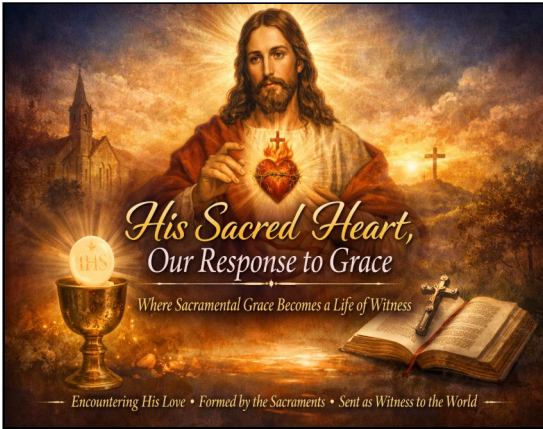
The Suscipe is often prayed during retreats, Eucharistic Adoration, or moments of discernment because it leads the soul toward deeper trust in God. It can also become a daily stewardship prayer, a reminder each morning that our lives are not our own, but gifts meant to glorify God.

The prayer Take, Lord, Receive echoes the words of St. Paul in Romans 12:1:

“Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God.”

Christian stewardship is ultimately an offering of self. Like St. Ignatius, we are invited to place everything into God’s hands, our freedom, dreams, struggles, gifts, and future, trusting that His grace is enough.

May we become faithful stewards who return all we are and all we have to the One who first gave everything to us.

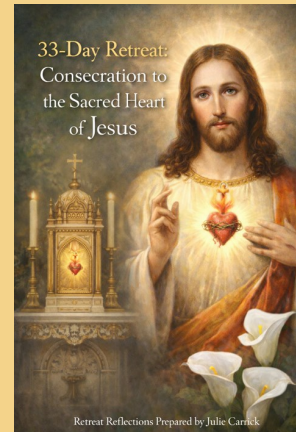

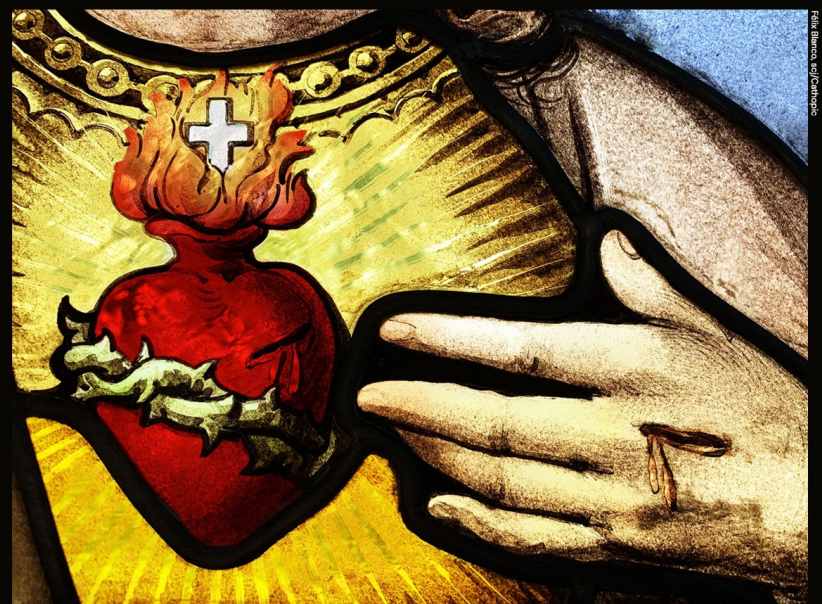

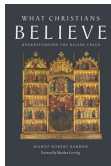
