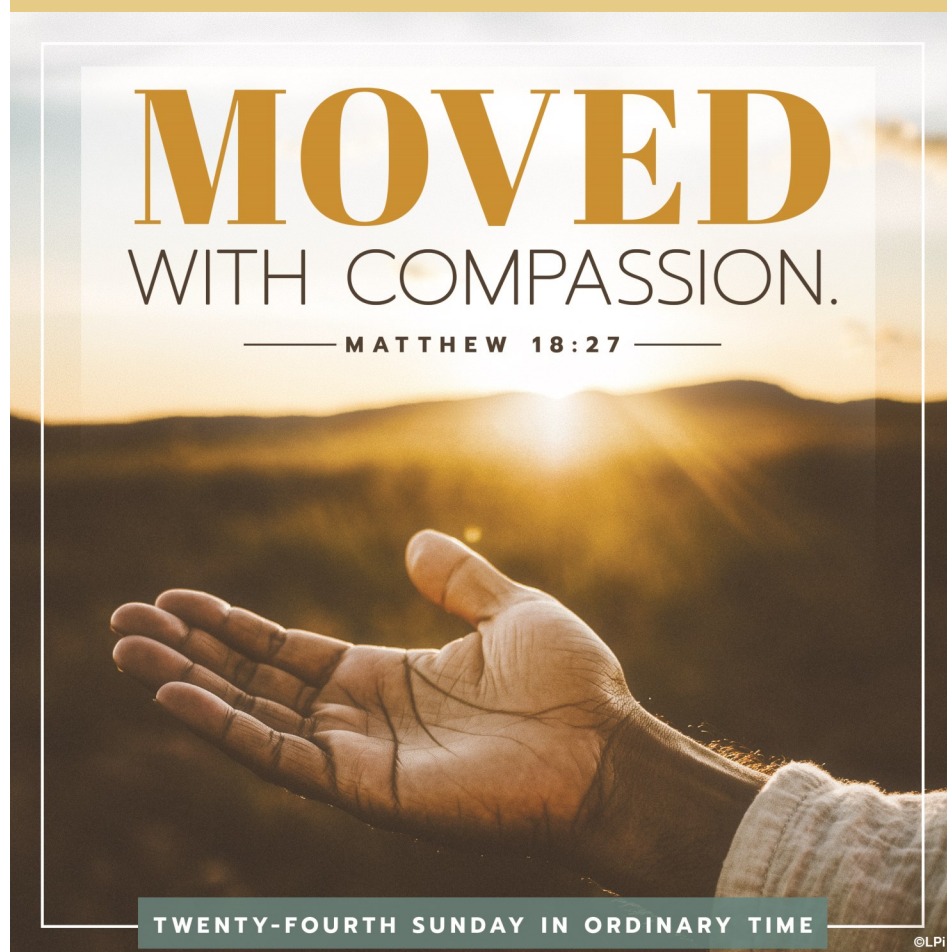

STEWARDSHIP



CHAPTER 6 ~ *Where God Dwells*

Heart of Jesus, House of God and Gate of Heaven

“Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.”
Matthew 28:20

We often think of a house as a place of belonging. It is where we return at the end of the day. It is where memories are made, meals are shared, and people know they are welcome.

The Litany gives Jesus a beautiful title:

Heart of Jesus, House of God and Gate of Heaven.

In the Heart of Jesus, we encounter the presence of God. Jesus makes the Father's love visible and invites us into communion with Him.

Moreover, through Christ, we are reminded that God's presence is not something reserved for a church building or a special moment. He desires to dwell in our hearts and in the ordinary places of our lives.

That changes the way we see the people around us. Every person we meet carries a dignity given by God. The person sitting beside us at Mass. The neighbor we rarely speak to. The coworker having a difficult day. The family member who may be struggling. Each is someone whom God loves.

Sometimes being a disciple simply means making another person feel that they have a place to belong. This is where stewardship becomes beautifully practical.

We steward more than our possessions. We steward relationships.

We give our time by listening.

We give our talents by helping.

We give our resources by sharing.

We give our presence by noticing someone who might otherwise feel invisible.

And we give hospitality by making room.

Our Parish Family is called to be a place where people encounter that same welcome. We may worship in different places and bring different traditions and experiences, but we share a common calling: to make Christ's love visible to one another and to those who walk through our doors.

A welcoming parish does not happen simply because the doors are open. It happens when hearts are open. Perhaps this week Jesus is inviting us to notice someone who needs a place to belong. Perhaps He is asking us to make room in our schedule, our home, our conversation, or our hearts.

The Heart of Jesus is both House of God and Gate of Heaven. He welcomes us into the Father's love, and then sends us out to become welcoming people ourselves.

Wherever we are, we can help make room for God.

And wherever we make room for another person, we may discover that Christ was already there.

Living the Heart This Week

Pray - Ask Jesus each morning: “Who needs me to make room for them today?” Then remain attentive to the answer.

At Home - Make intentional time this week to sit together without distractions. Listen to one another, not to fix anything, but simply to be present.

In Our Parish Family - Look beyond the people you already know. Introduce yourself to someone new or welcome someone who may be attending Mass alone.

Beyond Our Doors - Reach out to someone who may be lonely or going through a difficult time. A phone call, visit, or simple message can remind them they are not forgotten.

A Heart to Remember - When we make room for others, we make room for Christ.

Prayer - *Sacred Heart of Jesus, House of God and Gate of Heaven, make our hearts places where Your love can dwell. Teach us to recognize Your presence in those around us and to welcome others with the love You have first shown us. May our homes and our Parish Family be places where every person can encounter Your love.*

Heart of Jesus, make our hearts more like Yours. Amen.

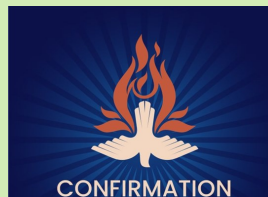

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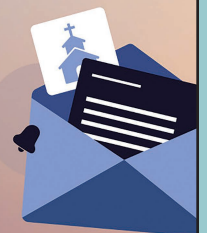
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
