## CHAPTER 5 ~ Making Room for God

### *Heart of Jesus, Holy Temple of God*

**“Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?”**

*1 Corinthians 3:16*

A temple is a place set apart for God. It is a place where we pause, become attentive, and remember that God is near. The Litany gives us a beautiful title for Jesus:

### **Heart of Jesus, Holy Temple of God.**

Jesus is the perfect dwelling place of God's presence. His entire life was centered on the Father. His words, His actions, His compassion, and even His moments of silence revealed a heart completely given to God.

And then St. Paul gives us something astonishing: we, too, are called to be temples of God.

God does not simply want a place in our lives. He desires our hearts. But making room for God can be difficult.

Our days fill quickly with responsibilities, work, family, appointments, commitments, screens, and distractions. Even good things can leave little room for silence.

Sometimes the question is not whether God is present. It is whether we have made room to notice Him. Stewardship begins here.

Before we can generously give our time, talents, or resources, we need to recognize that our lives themselves are gifts from God. Our first responsibility is not to fill every moment, but to allow God to be at the center of our lives. That might mean making time for prayer.

It might mean protecting Sunday Mass as sacred time.

It might mean putting away the phone and truly listening to someone we love.

It might mean creating a home where forgiveness, gratitude, and prayer have a place.

When we make room for God, something begins to change within us. We become more attentive to the needs of others.

We notice the person who needs encouragement. We recognize opportunities to serve. We become more grateful for what we have been given.

A heart that makes room for God becomes a heart that has room for others.

Our Parish Family also becomes stronger when we make room for one another. There is room for different gifts, different generations, different experiences, and different ways of serving. We do not have to be alike to belong. We simply need to make room.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus reminds us that holiness is not about escaping everyday life. It is about inviting God into the middle of it.

Into our homes. Into our work. Into our relationships. Into our Parish Family. Into our ordinary moments.

When we make room for God, even ordinary life can become a place where His love dwells.

### **Living the Heart This Week**

**Pray** - Set aside five quiet minutes each day with no phone, no distractions, and simply be present to God.

**At Home** - Choose one small way to make more room for God in your home this week—perhaps praying together, sharing a meal without screens, or beginning the day with gratitude.

**In Our Parish Family** - Notice someone who may need a place to belong. Offer a greeting, an invitation, or simply your attention.

**Beyond Our Doors** - Make room in your schedule for someone who needs your time. Sometimes the greatest gift we can give is simply being present.

### **A Heart to Remember**

When we make room for God in our hearts, we make more room for love in our lives.

**Prayer** - Sacred Heart of Jesus, Holy Temple of God, teach us to make room for You in every part of our lives.

**Heart of Jesus, make our hearts more like Yours. Amen.**

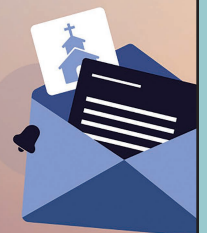
