

Reflections on Today's Gospel

This parable comes in the middle of Matthew's "eschatological discourse," two chapters that contain Jesus' words of warning about the end times. In chapter 24, Jesus tells his disciples to be "vigilant" because the end is coming. Then in chapter 25, he shifts from vigilance to foresight, prudently planning for the future we are watching out for. At a first reading, Jesus' parable seems quite clear: The five "wise" virgins were rewarded for their foresight, and the five "foolish" ones were rejected for their shortsightedness. Yet a closer reading may leave us befuddled. Jesus closes the parable by telling us to stay vigilant because we don't know when he will return. But in the parable itself, none of the ten virgins was vigilant. They all fell asleep (Matthew 25:5). If this parable is about vigilance, then it doesn't send a very good message.

Jesus knows that we cannot always be praying and actively seeking him. There are times when work or other important tasks take all of our focus. We also have times when we need to rest our minds and refresh ourselves through recreation. We simply cannot "stay awake" all the time!

This is where the difference between the two sets of virgins comes in. Combining vigilance with foresight, the wise virgins brought along extra oil to sustain them when they were asleep. They looked ahead and stocked up so that they could maintain their vigil no matter what their situation.

In a similar way, Jesus wants to make sure that we are getting filled up with his grace every day: through prayer, through the Eucharist, and through Scripture. He wants us to have plenty of his "oil" to take into our days so that we are always ready for him whether we are "awake" or "asleep." By combining foresight with vigilance, we can be certain that we will not be caught off guard when he returns!

"Lord Jesus, come and fill me up today so that I will be ready for you whenever you call."
