

Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17 The shepherd-king seeks the lost and heals the injured.


Psalms 23 "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want."

When Jesus identified himself as the Good Shepherd, his disciples probably recalled the passage from Ezekiel that we hear today. God's words are comforting at first, lovingly caring for the sheep, but at the end God stands in judgment, and some sheep God will destroy. This is the kind of shepherd Jesus suggests in the Gospel, separating the sheep from the goats in order to determine who is sent to eternal life and who to eternal punishment.
