



2026-2027 INTERNATIONAL STUDENT COST WORK PAPER

As part of the admissions process, Boise Bible College must receive a letter of guarantee sent by a person or agency assuring your financial support **and** return ticket to your native country or proof of sufficient personal funds for the same. This document will help you see how much financial support may be needed. All the amounts are estimates and are subject to change.

Part 1: Costs

For the 2026-2027 academic year the following estimates in \$USD are below:

On-campus

Tuition and Fees (12 credits):

\$12,004

Living Expenses (Food and Housing with on-campus housing for a single person):

\$9,106

Books, School Supplies, Apparel, Transportation and other costs:

\$1,838

Yearly Estimated Total: \$22,948

An additional cost of \$7,710 may be estimated for each dependent.

Off-campus

Tuition and Fees (12 credits):

\$12,004

Living Expenses (average cost of Food and Housing within driving distance of Boise Bible College):

\$11,011

Books, School Supplies, Apparel, Transportation and other costs:

\$4,208

Yearly Estimated Total: \$27,223

An additional cost of \$7,710 may be estimated for each dependent.

Part 2: Boise Bible College Funding

For the 2026-2027 academic year the following Boise Bible College financial aid estimates are below for incoming students in \$USD:

On-campus employment:

\$6,000 – maximum average yearly amount

(Need to apply and can only work 20 or less hours a week when classes are in session)

Possible Estimated Yearly Total of Aid: \$6,000

2. *Sponsors and Other Support:*

These are other organizations such as churches, sponsors, non-Boise Bible Scholarships, Government agencies, and other funding groups that will support your educational costs such as Tuition and Fees, Living Expenses, Books, Supplies and other costs.
