

Jim Coke, President Unit 505 Board of Directors

The Covid-19 epidemic seems to be slowly on the wane. Some bridge clubs are reopening including Foothill Bridge Club in Shingle Springs. (Check <u>Foothill Bridge</u> and Foothill Club page on pg. 12 for details.) I have heard rumblings that our two other brick and mortar clubs are looking to reopen in the near future.



The one thing all clubs are likely to have in common is that they will require you to be vaccinated and able to prove it before you may enter the building. Foothill already has this requirement and both Sacramento Bridge Center & Folsom Bridge Club are hinting that they will require vaccination as well. (Suggestion - if you haven't already been vaccinated then it is a good idea to do it. The odds are strongly in your favor. Only a small number of serious vaccine related complications have been reported out of almost 300,000,000 doses given vs. about 600,000 Covid-19 deaths. The vaccines may not be 100% effective but the roughly 90% efficacy seen in real life improves your odds of living dramatically.)

Note that the vaccination requirement to enter one of our brick and mortar clubs does not violate U.S. ADA laws because we do provide an accommodation of online bridge for those who can't be vaccinated for health reasons.

Foothill is also requiring masks but I don't know if the other clubs will have the same requirement. SBC and FBC are both waiting to see what the effect of the 15th of June announcement the state has promised as well as the requirements from their respective cities and county before they make their decisions. Based on the June 15 announcement from the state, Foothill may also change their safety protocol.

I haven't played in a live club yet because I am a bit cautious about it. I would like to see all levels of government agreeing that playing bridge live is approved. Part of this is personal safety and the other part is legal safety. Just getting sued can bankrupt our clubs and it doesn't matter who wins - the legal bills will be enough to bankrupt the club.

That said, the vaccination and mask requirements are strong enough that I won't criticize Foothill for opening a little early. I seriously considered going and playing myself.

A small note on team games: The BBO algorithm isn't very good for either odd numbers of teams or smallish numbers of teams. It can't handle a round robin and has a tendency to do "play backs" (playing a second round against a team you've already played in a previous round). BBO is aware of these issues and we hope to see a fix for them soon. But in the meantime, please be patient with us poor directors!

We had some sad news this past month. Ginny Curtis passed away peacefully in her sleep on the evening of May 19th. She will be missed by Sacramento area bridge community.



Normally, day & Swiss games cost \$6 and the Friday evening game costs \$3. (Special events may have a higher price.)


Please be on time for the game. *If you are late, the game can not start.* People who are late for a game will be removed from the game.
