The Monterey Regional had only 36% of the previous year's attendance thus leaving many rooms not filled and the District owing money for the block of rooms not filled. Note - Regional tournaments contracts with hotels contain a guarantee that a certain number of rooms will be sold in return for use of their large rooms to hold the games and other considerations. If the guarantee is not met then the District sponsoring the tournament owes the hotel money for the unused rooms in the guarantee.]

We will be having a Regional here in Sacramento and the District has asked for volunteers to help. Diane Strategos has volunteered to Chair and organize our volunteers, so please think about helping at the Regional. This used to be done by Pam Hughes and her group of folks, but the new District Board has decided to have a Regional Committee to plan the Regionals and the Units the Regionals are in help with volunteers.
