Folsom Bridge Center is Shutting Down!!

Susan Haynie announced that the club's landlord was evicting the club at the end of November. A valiant effort was made to find a new location but sky high rents made that difficult. The only possibility had two significant problems: the rent was high enough that the club would lose money every month and the parking situation was problematic. We counted parking spots, current usage, added our expected usage and found that we would have some of our members parking in other lots and walking to the club. This was not a tenable location. In the meantime, Folsom BC is going out of their to make the last days of the club be fun including waiving table fees and using all 7 Unit Games allocated to the club to send members off with a good feeling.

U505 December Sectional is Canceled!!

Normally, December is our smallest sectional and we expect this year would be no different. The September Sectional was just large enough to be financially successful but if we factor in the expected falloff in table count then the December Sectional does not produce sufficient revenue to be worth running. Our hope is that as the Covid situation stabilizes, we may reach a higher level of play that would enable December Sectionals.

U505 Clubs Are In Bad Shape

All 3 Sacramento area brick & mortar bridge clubs are in bad shape— none of them are in the black. Folsom BC losing their lease w/ CalFit was due to the fact they could only pay part of the rent. CalFit offered leniency on the rent for some time but they could not continue to make the offer indefinitely. Unfortunately, there is no viable alternative location for Folsom BC. Sacramento BC and Foothill BC are in a little better shape financially but they are both losing money every month. The virtual club is now a small fraction of what is was.

There are many reasons for not playing bridge but the clubs need players now. If you want to play at clubs in the future, then it is vital that you play now to keep the clubs alive. I realize that there are many good reasons for not playing bridge on a particular day but please make an effort to play on the days you can to keep our clubs alive.
