- **The Fellowship Hall** is now around 20 years old so we are needing to replace 4 HVAC units this fall. The replacement of the HVAC units will happen October 26 to November 13. The Fellowship Hall will not be available during this time period. The total cost of the project will be around \$160,000. We had a discussion of the project with trustees of both churches that led us to the conclusion that we should have an annual collection to support the current major repair along with future major repairs. For example, we still have 4 HVAC units that will need replaced along with potentially replacing the carpet in the future. People do not realize that the both church's maintenance funds actually fund most of the day-to-day expenses along with costs for major repairs. Currently the Fellowship Hall charges nominal fees rather than market value for events so the Fellowship Hall is not covering its own costs and repairs. By doing an annual collection for the Fellowship Hall this will help provide the funds necessary to reduce potential larger collections for future major repairs. In August we will put a reminder in both church's announcements about the Fellowship Hall collection. You can always contribute to the Fellowship Hall maintenance fund for major repairs throughout the year. Please note on your check "Fellowship Hall maintenance Fund".
