DASA's Sobering up Shelter provides supervised accommodation and care as an alternative to the police cells for people 'apprehended without arrest' for being intoxicated in a public place or self-referrals in need of a safe place to sober up.

Staff offer the clients a safe and clean place to 'sober up' and when appropriate they offer brief intervention and referrals to our Outreach Team and Aranda House Therapeutic Community.

Shelter Information:

- Referrals are also accepted from other service providers, and we also encourage self-referral to the Shelter.
- SUS Bus pick up from Alice Springs Hospital - 10pm, 12am, 2am (Sunday)



Eligibility Criteria:

- People aged 17 and over working, unemployed, Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander, non-Aboriginal regardless of (dis)ability, culture, sexual orientation or ability to afford services.
- Young people aged 14 to 18 who are referred by Alice Springs Youth Accommodation and Support Services (ASYASS)
- Straight, gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, inter-sex, or just not sure, you are ALL very welcome here.
