The Transitional After Care Unit (TACU) is a semi-independent residential facility where residents have their own bedroom and bathroom and shared common areas.

The focus of the Transitional After Care Unit is to provide a safe, supportive, clean and sober environment for residents to further progress in their journey of drug and alcohol rehabilitation, whilst Case Managers work with the resident to engage them in employment and education; and to reconnect with their families prior to moving back into the community.

## **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Resident must have abstained from alcohol or other drugs (unless prescribed by a medical practitioner) for a minimum of three months; which is confirmed by a referring agency such as a rehabilitation facility, a branch of Correctional Services or other health care provider.
- For self-referrals or referrals outside of these guidelines, contact the Residential Coordinator on 08 8950 3700 for a confidential discussion prior to completing the referral form.
- People aged 17 and over working, unemployed, Aboriginal and/or Torres
  Strait Islander people, non-Aboriginal regardless of (dis)ability, culture, sexual orientation or ability to afford services.
- Straight, gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, inter-sex, or just not sure, you are ALL very welcome here.
