Payment Policy

To secure the services we have been asked to perform, Noe-Brooks Funeral Home & Crematory requires payment in full prior to the rendering of these services. This can be accomplished through various means including:

- Cash
- Check

- Insurance Assignment

Our History

Bert Brooks, Sr. of Beaufort, NC co-owned his first funeral home with his friend, Manly Mason, of Newport, NC. Both were 1956 graduates of the American Academy of Funeral Service, New York, NY. Brooks & Mason Funeral Home operated from 1958 until 1966 in Beaufort when decisions were made to pursue other careers. Bert continued to hold an interest in pursuing the funeral business and decided to return to the profession in 1978 when George W. Dill & Sons Funeral Home of Morehead City became available for purchase. The name of the business was changed to Brooks Funeral Home in 1982 and the Brooks family, Bert, Sr., his wife, Jerri and their two sons, Bert, Jr. and Scott operated at the original Dill location until 1987. With the support of the community and the steady growth of the business, the Brooks family were able to relocate and build a new facility adjacent to Carteret General Hospital and Medical Park in Morehead City. Brooks Funeral Home & Crematory has been operating at its current location since construction was completed in 1987.

Bert Brooks, Jr. died in November of 2004 from complications of Hodgkin's Lymphoma. Bert Brooks, Sr. died shortly thereafter in December of 2006 from Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS). In April of 2017, Scott Brooks and his mother Jerri made the decision to sell the family business. The funeral home was privately owned and operated by Taylor Green of Texas until it was purchased by the Noe family in June of 2020 and the name was changed to Noe-Brooks Funeral Home and Crematory. Today Noe-Brooks Funeral Home is family owned and operated by Chris Noe and his family.

Anatomical Donation Fee

This fee includes removal from the place of death (within 50 mile local service radius), basic services of funeral director and staff, to include any possible necessary coordination with receiving medical school or facility and/or the securing and filing of any necessary or legal authorization forms. Transportation outside our local service radius will be added at a rate of \$2.75 per mile. This fee does not include use of facilities or services of staff for viewing or ceremony.....\$425.00

Transportation Charges

For funeral services held outside our local service area, we must charge additional transportation charges for **each** of our vehicles involved in the service. These charges are added to the service you selected, per vehicle involved in the service. These prices are effective as of April 1, 2025 and are only estimates of the mileage change. The exact mileage will be determined at time of use and are subject to change without notice. **Trips that require overnight lodging, add \$200.00.**

If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff and Overhead.....\$1195.00

Our fee for the services of funeral director and minimum staff includes, but is not limited to, staff response to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, i.e. cemetery, crematory and others. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming.....\$732.00

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
