Deacon Len was born in Camden, N.J. on September 16, 1948. He was a parishioner of St. Peter & Paul Parish and attended parish elementary school. He graduated from Camden Catholic High School and attended the University of Dayton, Rutgers University and Warton School University of Pennsylvania.



He studied with the Diocese of Camden for four years and was ordained a permanent Deacon on October 15, 1988 by Bishop George Guilfoyle. He served at the Parishes of St. Gregory (Magnolia, NJ), St. Rita (Bellmawr, NJ) and Holy Child Parish. We thank Deacon Len for sharing his expertise, wisdom and sense of humor with all of us over the years. He will be greatly missed here.

He is married to Patricia (Conway) Carlucci and has three children, Dominic, Maria (Carlucci) Pacifico and Theresa (Carlucci) Brogby. He has five grandchildren, Melissa Pacifico, Ronald Pacifico, Dominique Carlucci, Angelina Carlucci and Matthew Brogley.

Deacon Len worked for RCA and Lockheed Martin for 39 years retiring in 2010. He also was very involved with many organizations. The organizations he belonged to were the Holy Name Society, Knights of Columbus, and on October of 2022 was made a Knight of the Holy Sepulcher by Cardinal Dolan of N.Y. He was a member of the Diaconate advisory board of the Diocese of Camden for 6 years, also appointed an advocate for the petitioner for annulments by Bishop Sullivan.

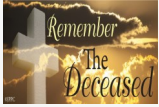
