This past Thursday, January 22nd, was the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. While the 2022 Dobbs Decision radically changed the Pro-Life landscape, the work to uphold the sanctity of human life from the

moment of conception and the dignity of women continues. As a Church and as a people of faith we are called to pray for the total restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. We are called to engage in acts of penance as reparation for the countless innocent lives lost and the blatant assault on motherhood. Finally, our Lord calls us to advocate for the sake of families in crisis. It is not enough to say that abortion should end. As a Church we are to accompany budding families who need our help. No mother should feel that she carries her child alone. Not only do we celebrate the birth of each child as unique, unrepeatable and loved by God, we walk with mothers in need, assisting with their spiritual, emotional and financial needs. We condemn abortion as an intrinsic evil (in other words, it is evil by its very nature). We show mercy and long for the conversion of sinners as a Church of poor sinners. God has carefully, tenderly created every person in His own image and likeness, to be in a loving relationship with Himself. From each tiny child knit within a mother's womb, to every person approaching death, all are loved perfectly and completely by God: "It is therefore a service of love which we are all committed to ensure to our neighbor, that his or her life may be always defended and promoted, especially when it is weak or threatened" (Evangelium vitae 77). Therefore, let us take courage and offer prayer and penance, that all human life would be welcomed in love and protected in law. In closing, we turn to the words of Pope St. John Paul II: *A great prayer for life is urgently needed, a prayer which will rise up throughout the world. Through special initiatives and in daily prayer, may an impassioned plea rise to God, the Creator and lover of life, from every Christian community, from every group and association, from every family and from the heart of every believer.*

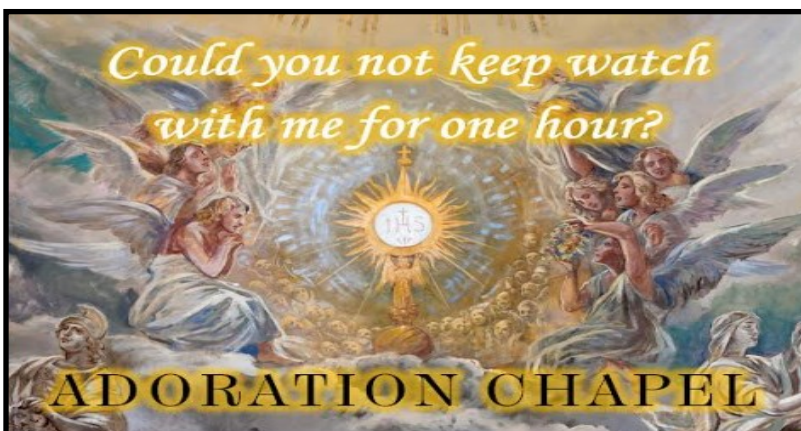

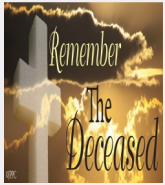
