Blessed are you, O Virgin Mary, who bore the Creator of all things. You became the Mother of your Maker, and you remain forever Virgin. Next Friday. November 21st is the Memori-

gin. Next Friday, November 21st is the Memorial of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In the Orthodox Church, the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary is considered one of the Twelve Great Feasts, celebrations that focus on the lives of Jesus and Mary. The word feast comes from the Latin **festus** which is translated as "joyous". This memorial, along with its 11 other counterparts, have a major significance in the story of God's plan of salvation. The account of Mary's birth and her early life aren't a part of the 27 books of the New Testament, but rather from the 2nd c. Christian work, the **Protoevangelium of** James (also known as the Gospel of James). The work, attributed to James the brother of the Lord, was well known by the Early Church Fathers Origin and Clement of Alexandria and was probably written around 150 AD and elaborates and expands upon the accounts of Jesus' birth in Matthew's and Luke's Gospel. The first part of the Gospel of James depicts the story of Mary's birth, education and marriage to St. Joseph. It's also where we read the story of Mary's parents, Joachim and Anne. The Protoevangelium of James is considered apocryphal, namely, not divinely inspired by the Holy Spirit or part of the canon (73 books) of Sacred Scripture, but rather a spiritual (and often imaginative) work meant to convey a specific point or message. In the case of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Gospel of James shows that Mary was consecrated to God from the very beginning of her life and that the Lord set Mary apart as the eventual Mother of the Savior. The depictions of Mary's early life and sanctity prefigure her "Yes" to God at the Annunciation. As we focus on Mary's holiness, obedience, as well as her openness to God's will, we are reminded that we, too, can offer ourselves entirely to God, just as Mary did. As we venerate the glorious memory of the most holy Virgin Mary, grant, we pray, O Lord, through her intercession, that we, too, may merit to receive from the fullness of your grace.




