




Happy Gaudete Sunday! While the last 2 weeks have focused on the 2nd Coming of Christ, the 3rd and 4th weeks of Advent are the more proximate preparation for the Church's celebration of the Birth of the Savior! On Friday night we celebrated 'Lessons and Carols' which originally was designed to keep people

out of pubs on Christmas Eve in the late 1800s. In its modern adaptation, the biblical 'lessons' walk us through the whole of salvation history from the Book of Genesis to the Gospels. The promise of God's covenant with His Chosen People culminates with the birth of the Christ Child - God becoming Man in order to save us from our sins. 


