For many, the Christmas season ends with New Year's Day. For others, it has already ended. But for the Church, our Christmas celebration continues and the Christmas season doesn't end until January 11th with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord. Throughout the Church's Christmas season there are so many traditions and feast days that help give added meaning and emphasis regarding the birth of our Savior. One of those traditions are the 12 Days of Christmas. It marks the time between Christmas Day and the Feast of the Epiphany on January 6th (although the Catholic Church in the US celebrates the Epiphany on the 2nd Sunday after Christmas). The origin of the 12 Days of Christmas comes from one of the many Councils of Tours, this one in particular being held in 567 AD. The Council Fathers decreed that every day between Christmas and the Epiphany was a festival and should be celebrated as such. While I'm sure that we're all very familiar with the traditional carol of the 12 Days of Christmas, there are other important feast days between the 25th of December and the 6th of January. On December 26th the Church celebrates the Feast of St. Stephen, the first official martyr of the Church (Acts Chapters 6 and 7). On the 27th of December we have the feast of St. John the Evangelist, the beloved disciple. Normally on December 28th is the feast of the Holy Innocents, those children killed as King Herod searched for the Christ Child (Matthew 2:16-18). If there is no Sunday between Christmas and New Year's Day, the Feast of the Holy Family is celebrated on December 30th. January 1st is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. The Feast of the Circumcision of Christ in the *usus antiquior* ("ancient rite" aka the Traditional Latin Mass) is also celebrated on January 1st to mirror to the Jewish custom of circumcising a child 8 days after his birth. In the end, the Twelve Days of Christmas offer far more than a familiar carol or a festive countdown—they invite us to slow down, reflect, and appreciate the impact of the Birth of Christ. Rooted in centuries of tradition, these days encourage community, celebration, and spiritual contemplation. The Twelve Days serve as a reminder that the meaning of Christmas extends beyond a single day. By embracing their rhythm and symbolism, we preserve a richer, deeper understanding of the what God has done for us, His children, and to carry the awesomeness of His divine love into the new year.

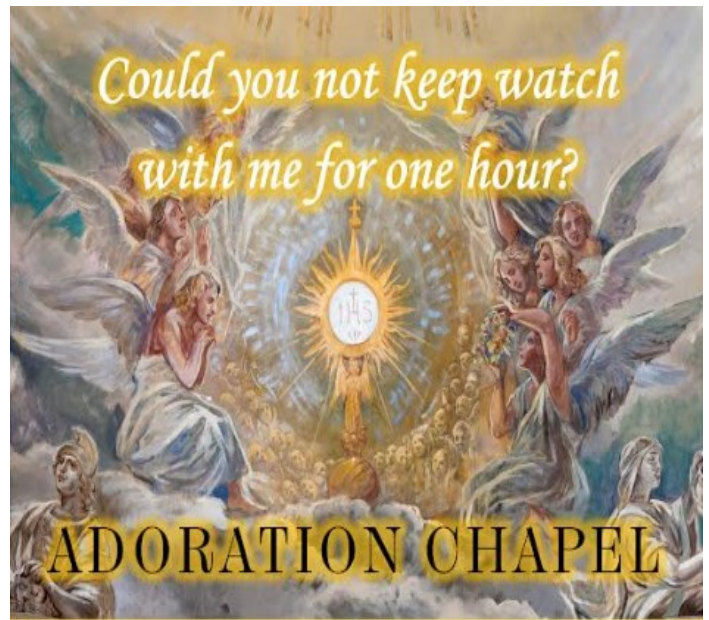
Creating a Family Rosary Shadow Box

INFANT OF PRAGUE NOVENA

*January 5 to 13 Novena - January 14 Feast Mass
St Teresa Church - 7pm*

The Novena to the Infant of Prague is a cherished devotion centered on the mystery of the Christ Child, God made flesh. The tradition of nine days of prayer comes from the Apostles and the Blessed Mother, who spent nine days in prayer between the Ascension and Pentecost (Acts 1:12-14). This became the model for Christian novenas throughout history.

The devotion to the Infant Jesus highlights the humility of the Incarnation, God choosing to come among us as a child and recalls the Gospel scenes of Jesus' childhood found in Matthew and Luke.

The crowned Infant holding a globe symbolizes Christ's kingship and His loving care over the world. In turn, the Novena to the Infant of Prague invites the faithful to come before the Christ Child with childlike confidence, entrusting our needs to the One who said: "Ask and you shall receive." Through this devotion, we remember that even in His infancy, Jesus is our King, our Provider, and our ever-present source of hope.

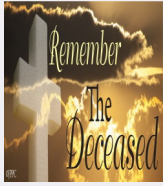
