This past week offered a rare and meaningful pairing: the feast days of **St. Patrick and St. Joseph**. Though very different in their lives and missions, their spirituality reveals two complementary paths of faith—bold witness and quiet fidelity. St. Patrick represents bold, outward faith. His missionary spirit and trust in God remind us to live our faith courageously and share it with others, even in uncertainty. He shows that God's presence goes with us wherever we are sent. In the most difficult times in St. Patrick's life, when he was afraid and his future far from clear, the Lord made His presence known. From that place of hardship, St. Patrick's heart turned to prayer and to the God who never left his side. St. Joseph, on the other hand, embodies quiet, hidden faith. Through silence, obedience, and trust, he teaches us that holiness is often found in ordinary responsibilities and unseen sacrifices. St. Joseph listens, discerns, and responds without hesitation—whether in accepting Mary, fleeing to Egypt, or raising Jesus in obscurity. His life teaches that holiness does not always appear dramatic or visible. Holiness can be steady, both protecting and providing — trusting in God and in His holy will. Together, these two saints offer a powerful balance. St. Patrick calls us to evangelize through word and action, and to trust boldly in God's guidance. St. Joseph calls us inward, to cultivate a listening heart, to act faithfully in the small and hidden moments, and to anchor our lives in quiet trust. To reflect on these two feast days in the same week is to be invited into a fuller vision of discipleship: one that is courageous yet gentle, active yet rooted, visible yet deeply interior. Their lives encourage us to ask not only how we can do great things for God, but also how we can be faithful in the ordinary—and to recognize that both are essential to a life of true holiness.

We're getting to the edge of Holy Week! Here are 7 simple Lenten Practices for the 5th Sunday of Lent:

- 1. Name What Feels “Dead”:** Take a quiet moment and ask: What in my life feels stuck, lifeless, or hopeless right now? Name it honestly — that's where Jesus wants to work.
- 2. Pray with Raw Honesty:** Bring your real feelings to prayer this week — disappointment, confusion, even frustration. God can handle it.
- 3. Wait Without Fixing Everything:** Practice patience in one situation where you usually rush to fix things. Let God work in the waiting.
- 4. Roll Away One Stone:** What's one obstacle you can move? A conversation you've been avoiding, a habit you need to change, a step you've been putting off — do that one thing.
- 5. Listen for God Calling Your Name:** Spend a few minutes in silence and imagine Jesus calling you personally. What might He be inviting you to step out of?
- 6. Let Others Help “Unbind” You:** Growth isn't solo. Reach out — talk to a friend, mentor, or spiritual guide about something you're carrying.
- 7. Choose One Act of Life:** Do one intentional act that brings life this week — encourage someone, repair a relationship, serve someone in need, or start something good you've been delaying.




Gospel Reflection

The story of the resurrection of Lazarus begins in a deeply human moment. When his sisters, Mary and Martha, send word to Jesus, "Lord, the one whom you love is sick." They don't demand a miracle or tell Jesus how to solve the problem. They simply share what they know... and then they wait.

They don't pretend everything is fine. They bring their worries and fears honestly to Jesus. Can we honestly say the same? How comfortable and confident are we in bringing our suffering, questions, hopes, and needs into our relationship with Him? Mary and Martha knew Jesus well enough to bring their needs to Him. They trusted Him enough to wait. And through their witness, others came to believe. Faith often begins in this very same way ... telling Jesus the truth of our lives and trusting Him with whatever happens next.

On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.'*"

Plenary Indulgence is the remission of any temporal punishment due to sin, meaning by fulfilling the special conditions, eight days prior to or after April 27, which include going to confession, receiving Holy Communion, praying for the Pope's intentions with an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be.




