"The cry of Jesus as he died, 'I thirst,' echoed every moment in my soul" - St. Thérèse of Lisieux



For the past 5 weeks, the Church has focused on turning away from sin and embracing the Gospel. Through prayer, fasting and almsgiving, through spiritual sacrifice and physical mortification we have strived to transform our lives and conform them ever closer to Christ. Now we shift to the Church's most sacred time in our proximate preparation for Easter- Holy Week. During Holy Week, the Church doesn't merely recall Jesus' Paschal Mystery (His Passion, Death, and Resurrection). We accompany Him to Calvary just as He accompanies us throughout every moment of our lives. We unite our crosses with His, just as Christ bore His cross for our sake. We readily hand over our suffering, just as the Savior of the World did not hesitate for one instant to suffer and die for His beloved children. Liturgically, this is such a rich and wonderful time. On Palm Sunday we have 'the Gospel before the Gospel' where we recount Jesus' entry into Jerusalem that is both triumphant and humbling. We have the Chrism Mass in which all of the oils used for Baptism, Confirmation, the Anointing of the Sick and Holy Orders for the upcoming year will be blessed. Holy Thursday, where we not only celebrate the first Eucharist and the establishment of the ministerial priesthood, but also enter deeper into the mystery that loving and following Christ means serving others and "washing their feet". We watch and pray at the Altar of Reposition like the disciples on the Mount of Olives. We walk the Way of the Cross as we acknowledge our role in Jesus' Passion and Death on Good Friday. We wait in quiet expectation for the Empty Tomb. As pastor, I encourage you to be a part of as much of Holy Week as you can! Even if we have struggled with our Lenten journey up to this point, these days can literally transform our lives!!!

Starting today, here is one spiritual thing to contemplate each day as we enter these final days of Lent:

Palm Sunday — Welcoming Jesus Fully: Do I welcome Jesus only when it's easy, or also when it costs me something?

Monday of Holy Week — Love That Is Lavish: What would it look like for me to love God generously, not minimally?

Tuesday of Holy Week — Facing Betrayal and Weakness: Where am I inconsistent or weak in my faith—and can I bring that honestly to God?

Wednesday of Holy Week — The Cost of Turning Away: What small compromises in my life are quietly pulling me away from God?

Holy Thursday — Humble Love and the Eucharist: How is Jesus inviting me to serve others with humility and receive His love more deeply?

Good Friday — The Cross: What does sacrificial love really mean—and where am I being asked to carry a cross?

Holy Saturday — Waiting in Silence: Can I trust God even when He seems silent or absent?

Baptism Scheduling



Journey Through Holy Week

"For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you." John 13:15

Holy Week stands at the heart of our liturgical year, inviting not just remembrance, but deep attentiveness. It is a sacred opportunity to exercise the openness and awareness cultivated through our Lenten practices, sharpening our hearts so we may more fully receive the meaning of Christ's final days. We invite all members of our parish community to enter fully into these holy days through prayer, reflection, and participation in the sacred liturgies and services.

Parish Reconciliation Service *A Time of Renewal* *Monday, March 30* *7PM @ St Teresa Church*

As we come towards the end of our Lenten journey, please join us as we reflect on our baptismal commitment. Join us for an evening of reflection followed by the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Divine Mercy Sunday Service *Sunday, April 12 @ 3PM* *St Teresa Church*

St Maria Faustina in the 1930's revealed to us the Lord's call for a special feast day, which Pope St John Paul named as Divine Mercy Sunday. St Faustina shared with us, "*Our Lord said, 'I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.'*"

Plenary Indulgence is the remission of any temporal punishment due to sin, meaning by fulfilling the special conditions, eight days prior to or after April 27, which include going to confession, receiving Holy Communion, praying for the Pope's intentions with an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be.

Please join us as we pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet followed by the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Also, we will have a special appearance by the Easter Bunny where pictures can be taken in Mary's Prayer Garden.




