



God will not abandon humanity. The Father sent his Only-Begotten Son to save us, and the Son of God, our Lord Jesus Christ, bestowed upon us the Holy Spirit, to make us sharers in his divine life, preserving and protecting the sacredness of the human person. By the Holy Spirit we know and experience that God is with us. For this reason, in our prayer we entrust to God every human being, especially those in need, those who experience hunger, loneliness or illness. We invoke upon each member of the human family every grace and blessing so that “their hearts may be encouraged, as they are knit together in love, to have all the riches of assured understanding and the knowledge of God’s mystery,” who is our Lord Jesus Christ (Col 2:2). - Pope Leo XIV



Today, as we celebrate Jesus Christ risen from the dead, we give thanks to Almighty God that He has not abandoned us. Through the Resurrection, Jesus, the Son of God, conquers sin and death forever. The empty tomb becomes the great symbol of our Lord's victory. Easter is more than just a commemoration or a history lesson. Easter is a proclamation of our faith - that Jesus Christ just didn't rise from the dead in the past. Jesus Christ IS risen from the dead Alleluia! It is the Church's proclamation that our Lord and Savior, the Messiah, lives, not in a particular moment in time, but forever! And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life (cf. Rom 6:4). Death was not the end for Jesus, and by His saving action on the cross, death is not the end for us. So the gift and the challenge is how do we live and celebrate the life we have been given? How do we proclaim that Jesus is truly risen from the dead? How do we live our lives as believers in the Resurrection? The answers to these questions point towards the way that we live our lives. Regardless of the answer, whether we are fully living out our life of faith, or have a long way to go in our relationship with Christ and His Church, we're in the right place! A parish isn't just a building; it's a spiritual home. Through the sacraments and through the Church's feasts (like Christmas and Easter), a parish becomes the backdrop of our lives. The practice of our faith not only means being a part of a community, but also speaking spiritual language week after week, Sunday after Sunday. I encourage and invite you and your family this Easter to be a member of Holy Child. For membership is more than being "on the books" but rather having a lifetime of connection to God, to others and to this place that we call home! God bless you all and Happy Easter!

With praise and thanksgiving for the glory of the Resurrection, the fast of new recipes to try is over! One of the recipes I made on a Saturday night was this beauty: Cajun Chicken, Shrimp and Sausage Pasta! A combination of both spicy and creamy, it was really good. 

## Divine Mercy Sunday Service, April 12 3PM @ St Teresa Church

St Maria Faustina in the 1930's revealed to us the Lord's call for a special feast day, which Pope St John Paul named as Divine Mercy Sunday. St Faustina shared with us, "Our Lord said, "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy."

**Plenary Indulgence** is the remission of any temporal punishment due to sin, meaning by fulfilling the special conditions, eight days prior to or after April 12, which include going to confession, receiving Holy Communion, praying for the Pope's intentions with an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be.

*Please join us as we pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet followed by the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This is a Prayer Service Only.*




