“Merciful Father, in the name of Thy sweet Jesus, of the Blessed Virgin and of the Saints, I pray Thee that my sister be fired with Thy spirit of love, and that Thou wilt grant her the grace to make Thee greatly loved.” ~ St. Thérèse of Lisieux

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the last celebration of the Easter season, I thought it appropriate to look at the writings of one of our two patronesses, St. Thérèse of Lisieux (aka St. Teresa of the Child Jesus) concerning the Holy Spirit. The Little Flower believed that the Holy Spirit was responsible, not only for her conversion and growth in holiness, but also inspired her in specific moments of her life. St. Thérèse saw God lovingly reach out to embrace her in His divine providence through the activity of the Holy Spirit. What EXACTLY does that mean? Divine providence refers to God’s loving, active, and wise guidance of all creation toward its ultimate perfection, namely communion with God forever in heaven. It shows us that the Lord is actively involved in our daily lives. So anything in life, especially a calling from God, comes under the influence of divine providence. For Thérèse, the Lord called her for a specific purpose - the use of love in order to grow closer to God's heart. St. Thérèse focused on the Holy Spirit as the spirit of love. Pope St. John Paul II, when he declared the Little Flower as a Doctor of the Church, wrote that it was the longing of every human heart to embrace his or her role as adoptive children of the Father. This relationship, of being adopted sons and daughters through the Son, was possible through the movement of the Holy Spirit. So in synopsis, the Holy Spirit, the spirit of love, helped St. Thérèse become a true child of God the Father. The Holy Spirit was the constant companion in helping the Little Flower grow in her role as a daughter to the Most High. The awesome reality is that you don't have to be one of the greatest saints in modern history to have the Holy Spirit be a part of your life. The Holy Spirit helps form us in our roles as sons and daughters. As St. Paul reminds us, "For those who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a spirit of adoption, through which we cry, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit itself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if only we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him" (Rom 8:14-17). So on this feast of Pentecost, let us learn from the spirituality of St. Thérèse: God is Love, and the Holy Spirit is that Love poured into our hearts. The Holy Spirit, the spirit of love is at the heart of the Church, bringing life to every aspect of Her mission. Come Holy Spirit! Fill the hearts of Your faithful! Enkindle in them the fire of Your Divine Love! Send forth Your Spirit and we shall be created and You shall renew the face of the earth!

Since it's Pentecost, it's time to bring the heat! I'm a big fan of spicy foods, but I recognize that my level of "heat resistance" may not be the same as yours. So in the spirit of not burning away your taste buds (and in conjunction with the beginning of grilling season), I recommend these Honey, Lime and Sriracha Chicken Skewers. The "heat" of Sriracha will be muted by the honey (unless you want to double down and use Mike's Hot Honey). 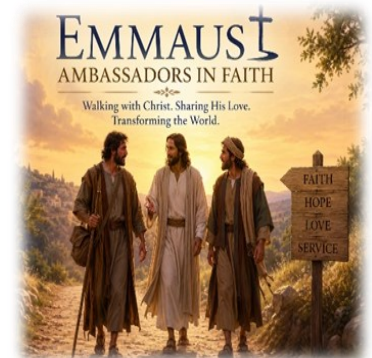
Each event provides a unique opportunity to guide parishioners of all ages in faith helping to build a personal relationship with God.

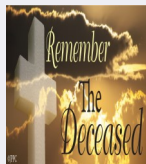
Altar Servers: Four to six altar servers are needed to carry candles, cross and incense.
