On June 11, 2026, as part of the celebration of the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the USCCB, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops consecrated the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Diocese of Camden on June 12th had a Mass and Eucharistic Procession at St. Mary's Church in Gloucester City. The parish has the distinction of being the oldest in the Diocese of Camden, founded on January 1, 1848 by Bishop Kenrick of Philadelphia. Holy Child also prayed a Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus leading up to the feast day. This solemnity has a rich theological history going back nearly a thousand years. Devotion to the wounded heart of Jesus goes back to the 11th c. when Christians meditated on the 5 Holy Wounds of Christ. From those prayers came a focus on Jesus' Sacred Heart, focusing on His passion and death. The private revelation to St. Gertrude the Great in the 13th c. also fostered the devotion. St. John Eudes composed and celebrated a Mass of the Sacred Heart in France in August of 1670 that was approved by his bishop and soon spread throughout France. You may be familiar with the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a cloistered French nun, who in 1673 received the first of four visions of our Lord revealing His Sacred Heart and desiring that a feast be instituted in its honor. Our Lord asked Catholics to receive Holy Communion on the first Friday of the month and adore Him in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Closely connected to the feast of Corpus Christi (which traditionally is celebrated 60 days after Easter), the feast of the Sacred Heart was made universal for the entire Church by Blessed Pope Pius IX in 1856. The central message of our devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is the infinite and compassionate love poured forth from the Heart of Jesus. It emphasizes His sacrifice and invites us to respond to His love. The Sacred Heart calls us to make reparation for sins, especially indifference and ingratitude toward Him. This feast day is more than a pious custom, but rather a direct response to our Lord's own invitation to gaze upon His love and to offer our hearts in return.

**Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!
Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!**

The feast of the Sacred Heart is the highest form of liturgical celebration: a solemnity! While many Catholics abstain from meat on Fridays, we traditionally don't fast or abstain on solemnities. So it's possible (and encouraged) to have meat! While you have to wait until next year to have your share of meat for the Sacred Heart (Friday, June 4th, 2027 to be exact), I give you one of my favorite recipes when it comes to meat: PRIME RIB! I have used this recipe from Kendall-Jackson SEVERAL times and it does not disappoint! Now I know everything is insanely expensive right now and you may not currently have the funds for a 4 ½ pound Prime Rib, but remember that as of my writing this article, you have 361 days to put some money aside. \$5 a week is more than sufficient. A couple of helpful hints. Make sure your roast is room temperature (30 minutes outside the refrigerator should do the trick). Also make sure that your kitchen is WELL VENTILATED! This bad boy, when cooking at 500 degrees, puts out a lot of what firefighters call "grease-laden vapors". These tend to set off smoke detectors if you're not careful. 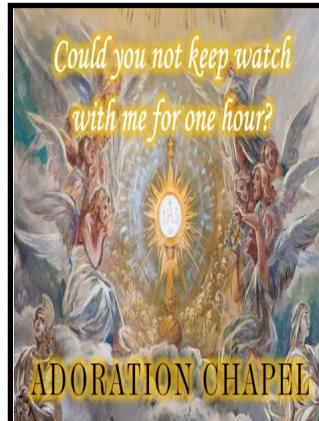

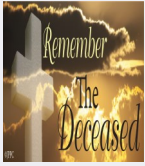
